This is not main building, only
 a guest cottage, of which there are
 three. I have been with Mr. [REDACTED]
 [REDACTED] for 21 years. You
 may have heard of him, I took time
 out from Sep. 42 to Sep. 44- to go
 in the armed forces, was 62 at time of
 enlistment, returned to castle on
 night watchman, now as when I
 saw the discs, which was about the
 last of October. Did not know of any
 one to write to, about them, saw the
 articles in the Past, so concluded to
 write you. There were only a few at the
 castle at time I saw the discs all had
 returned so did not get any one up

prob since I predicted that I did
not get them up. but thought
they would likely stop before I could
get them there. I first noticed these
discs making my first round of the
night. at 9. A.M. saw one. then stopped
of course to wonder about it. had heard
of discs before. well I stood there and
counted 16. coming at about two
minute intervals. started on around.
they kept coming, so just kept watch-
ing them kept going until about
10. Clock, saw about 60 of them.
all emerged from behind Red Rock
went out of sight behind Pat Garrison.
this is no optical illusion, I
saw them, so that. this is rather
in the Mts. about 1900 feet above
sea level. about 4-miles from sea
shore. discs were traveling from
back in Mts. toward coast, direc-
tion a little S. of West.

guess this is about all I can
tell you. but I saw them and
no guess work about it. regret very
much I was alone.

<p>Following is copy of letter forwarded by Headquarters Sixth Army, Presidio of San Francisco, California, written by [REDACTED]</p> <p>"San Simeon, Calif 4/12/49 To Gen Mark Clark</p> <p>Dear Mr Clark,</p> <p>Am writing you in regard to what I witnessed one night in late September, possibly some-thing no other person has ever seen. have wanted to write someone about it, but did not know whom to write, so saw clipping in S. F. Examiner last night, which I enclose. On about Sep 28, I was on duty at the castle, at night, at 9 o'clock was making my rounds. Saw a light going between the two mts, stopped to look at it. In about two minutes another. Of course I began to wonder, stood there and counted 16 discs pass between the two peaks. had of course read of flying discs. Well I watched them then. Kept coming at two minute intervals until eleven o'clock they were traveling at very high speed. This is mountainous country have often wondered where they could have come from, were apparently flat from where I stood. seemed to be about 20 in, in diameter.</p> <p>Give you a little of my background so you will not think I have been seeing things. have been with Mr. Hearst for 21 years when the war come along I volunteered at age of 32 years in coast guard, served 3 years until Sep 1945, come back to ranch, spent most of my time in San Francisco, guard on the Embarcadero on ships and docks.
