

Questionnaire Checks Flying Saucer Stories

WASHINGTON, April 23 (AP)—If you think you've seen a flying saucer, the air force has a standard questionnaire for you to fill out.

It is part of "Project Saucer," the two-year-old search of the

technical intelligence division into stories that have spread about the country as swiftly as the rumored flying disks.

The air force says it has found normal answers for about 60 percent of the 270 cases it has inves-

tigated. But it has left a question mark behind the other 40 percent.

Some cases involve reported sightings by experienced air-men. One national guard pilot died because he pursued something too high.

The Daily News, a local paper and under the date-line of " Washington, April 28 (AP) - states the following:
Questionnaire Checks Flying Saucer Stories.

This is to state that I, on several occasions since last winter have seen what appears to have been an object or rocket hurtling through the sky during the late night and early hours of the morning. The objects were apparently traveling at a high rate of speed, and were traveling across the sky in nearly a straight line of flight and the objects or object was traveling from " N.E. to " S.W. and the object did not have the appearance of a meteor or act as a meteor - generally does such as diminishing in color or streaks, but rather this was " constant in flight with Blue-Green and White pattern of exhaust and quite wide.
