## SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

1. An unidentified flying object was sighted near Albuquerque, New Mexico, from a point where the Kirtland Field perimeter fence crosses the Ordnance Area road on 10 March, 1949. Details of the sighting are as follows:

- (a) Observer: Cpl. Paul James Hutchinson, ASN RA 11008369, 8457th M.P. Company, 8450th M.P. Group, Sandia Base.
- (b) Time of sighting: 2200 to 2215, 10 March, 1949.
- (c) Location of sighting: On the Ordnance Area road where it intersects the Kirtland Field perimeter fence.
- (d) Weather: Clear.
- (e) Witnesses: None.
- (f) Photographs: None.
- (g) Object sighted:
  - (1) Number: One.
  - (2) Shape: Spherical.
  - (3) Size: Two times the size of an automobile headlight.
  - (4) Color: Yellow.
  - (5) Speed: Estimated 200 MPH.
  - (6) Direction of travel: East to west.
  - (7) Maneuverability: No deviation from the horizontal path.
  - (8) Altitude: 30° to 40° elevation from the point of observation.
  - (9) Sound: None.
  - (10) Exhaust trail: None.

2. Transit measurements were not available.

- (a) Vertical azimuth: approximately 30° - 40°
- (b) Horizontal azimuth: 40° - 50°.
