

Keithley, received a long distance phone call from a Mr. [REDACTED], saying that he had observed objects shaped like balloons on that date (28 April) at 1800 hours, traveling on a heading of 340°, at 80 - 100 mph., over Indianapolis, Indiana, at an altitude of some 3000 - 4000 feet.

2. This is all the information available. An effort was made to trace the phone call to find out where the civilian lived, but the call was paid for by him, and since no record of incoming paid calls is maintained at Chanute AFB, we were unable to find his full name or his address.

3. Captain Keithley said he believed Mr. [REDACTED], an ex-T Sgt., lived 40 - 50 miles north of Indianapolis.
