

1 Main 4 ft long $\frac{1}{2}$ in width $\frac{1}{8}$ of an inch thick
4 inside - 2 ft long $\frac{1}{2}$ in or less width $\frac{1}{8}$ of an inch thick
+ 5 outside edges - 3 ft long about $\frac{1}{2}$ width - $\frac{1}{8}$ of an inch thick
+ maybe one 3 ft long missing.

Top of aircraft - all white

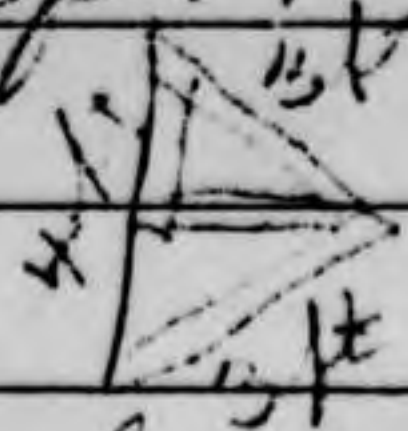

It folds up easily to a triangle 4 ft by 3 ft.



Rubber on balloon is pink and when you stretch it pink goes away and you can see through the rubber.

Mozzle on balloon is Red with long and thin round. Printed on inside of balloon is
