SIGHTING MADE WITH NAKED EYE. MADE VERY ROUGH ESTIMATION OF ALTITUDE AS FIVE THOUSAND; UNABLE TO ESTIMATE SPEED. WEATHER CLEAR, VISABILITY MORE THAN 10 MILES; NO PHENOMENA REPORTED. OBSERVATION OF OBJECT MADE BETWEEN HOURS OF 0500Z AND 0600Z. CHECK WITH BOLLING AND ANDREWS AIR FORCE BASES, WASHINGTON RADAR, AIR ROUTE TRAFFIC CONTROL, FIGHTER INTERCEPT, AND NATIONAL AIRPORT ELICITED NEGATIVE REPORTS. NATIONAL AIRPORT REPORTS AIRLINERS AS TRAFFIC DURING PERIOD, ALL OF WHICH PASSED THROUGH THE AREA IN WHICH OBJECT REPORTED; CREW MEMBERS DID NOT REPORT ANY UNUSUAL SIGHTINGS.
