on 27 June 1952 Mrs [redacted]  
of [redacted] Bronx, NY, telephone [redacted]  
[redacted] reported to Capt Hausman  
of the Public Information Office, <sup>Dept. of Defense, York,</sup> in New York,  
Telephone Rector 29100, extension 260, that  
she, her husband, two children and a  
neighbor had seen a flying saucer. Her  
conclusion that the object was a flying  
saucer was stimulated by her neighbor  
who, after hearing her ~~of~~ experience, said  
she had seen a flying saucer.

Capt Hausman was contacted <sup>by telephone</sup> and  
gave a brief description of the incident. Mrs  
Oppenheimer was contacted and gave  
the following description.

While <sup>reclining</sup> on the roof of her  
apartment building early Friday morning  
June 27 Mrs [redacted] observed a  
round, disc-shaped object hovering in  
the direction of Laguardia Airport. The  
object then stood up on end and coasted off  
at terrific speed toward downtown Manhattan.  
It was a thick object with a dull gray  
light around it. When the object disappeared

it did so quite suddenly.


