1. Twenty unidentified flying objects were observed over Burley and Paul, Idaho 29 July 1952. Sighting occurred at 2150EST and objects were visible for a very short period due to a high rate of speed.

2. The twenty objects were sighted very high and moving very fast from north to south. The objects were oval in shape and trailing a tail of flame approximately three times the length of the object. Size and color were not established. Objects were flying in a rounded V formation. No aerodynamic features nor sound were evidenced. The objects were sighted visually from the surface in the cities of Burley and Paul, Idaho. No altitudes were given.

3. Weather in the area at the time of sighting: Clear, 30 miles visibility, winds aloft 30,000 feet, 290°, 30 knots, 40,000 feet, 280°, 30 knots.

4. Witnesses: Mr. [REDACTED], Paul, Idaho, telephone [REDACTED]; Mr. [REDACTED], Burley, Idaho, telephone [REDACTED], and Mr. [REDACTED], Burley, Idaho, telephone [REDACTED]

5. Air traffic in the area at the time of sighting was AF 7526, a C-46 over Burley at 2205EST. The pilot of this aircraft reported seeing no objects.




23. In the following sketch place an "A" at the position the object was when you first saw it, and a "B" at its position when you last saw it.
