THE OBJECT SIGHTED. CIVILIAN AIR PATROL AT GREENVILLE, MISS. REPORTED SIGHTING THE SAME OBJECT OVER GREENVILLE AT 2129C. MEMPHIS ARTC ALERTED MISS. AND TENN. HIGHWAY PATROLS. MEMPHIS AFB REPORTED THAT A T-11 AIRCRAFT LANDED THERE AT 2230C. AIRCRAFT HAD RED WINGS, TAIL, AND PASSING LIGHTS AND LOADED "WIRED". PILOT OF AIRCRAFT SAID THAT HE WAS OVER GREENWOOD AT 2105C, CIRCLED TWICE, AND SIGHTED ANOTHER AIRCRAFT IN AIR. HE THEN PROCEEDED TO GREENVILLE WHICH HE ALSO CIRCLED.

AT 2045C 15 JULY 52, GREENWOOD RADIO AT GREENWOOD, MISS. RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM BASE OPERATOR AT TCHULA, MISS. MR. TOWNSEND. REPORTED SEEING A RED CYLINDER TRAVELLING NORTH FROM THAT LOCATION. THE COMMUNICATOR AT GREENWOOD IN COMPANY WITH FOUR OTHER PERSONS REPORTED THAT AT 2105C THEY SIGHTED THIS OBJECT APPROACH GREENWOOD FROM THE SOUTH. IT WAS ESTIMATED TO BE FIVE OR SIX THOUSAND FEET ABOVE THE GROUND AND HOVERED OVER GREENWOOD FOR SEVERAL MINUTES AND THEN PROCEEDED NORTH AT VERY HIGH SPEED. THE OBJECT MADE NO SOUND. IT HAD THREE LARGE RED LIGHTS GROUPED TOGETHER. THERE WAS AN UNIDENTIFIED AIRCRAFT CIRCLING AT A HIGHER ALTITUDE.
