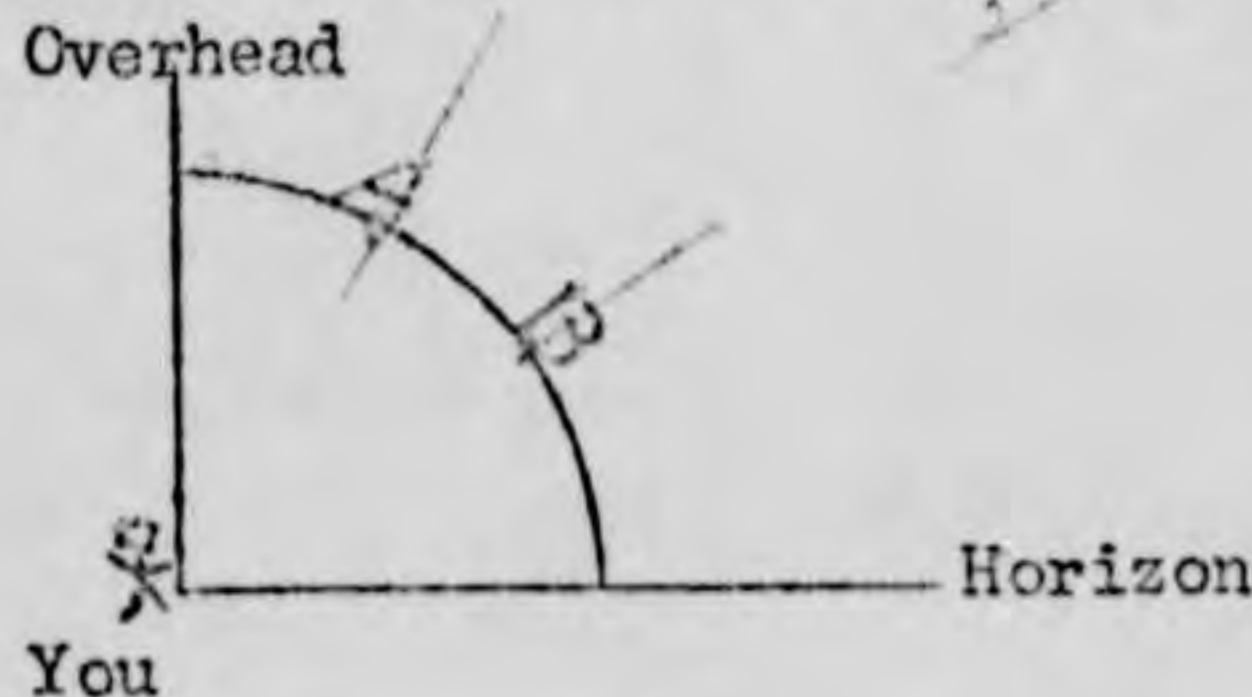

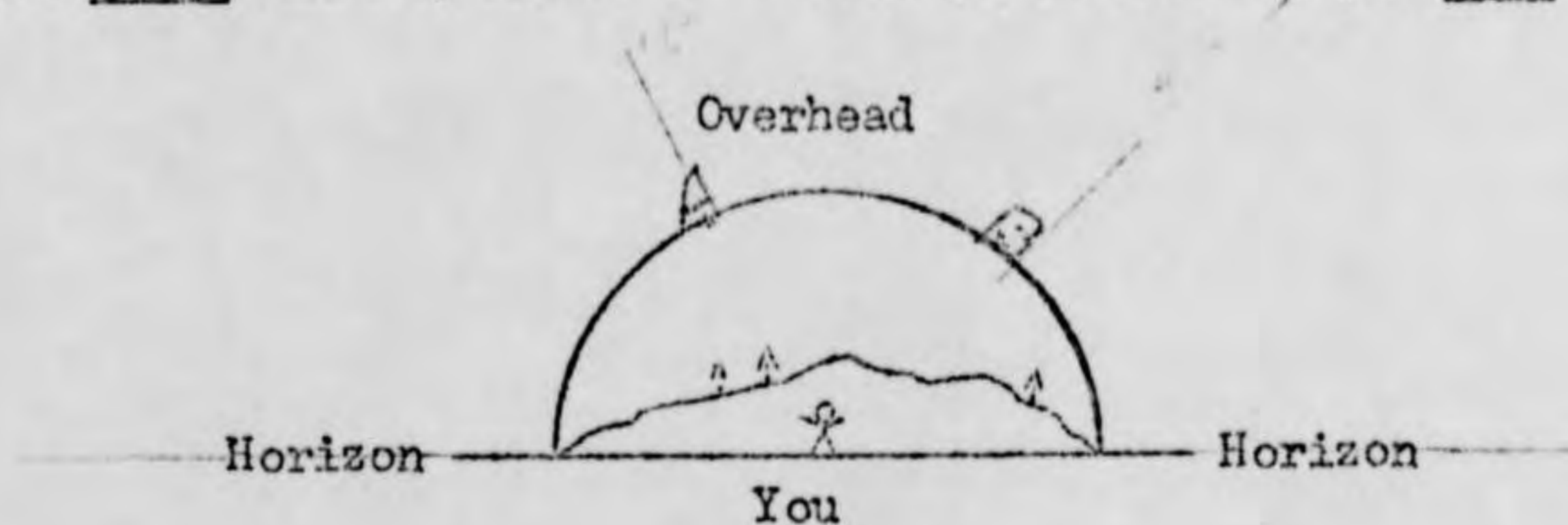

When we first saw the objects, we naturally thought of "flying saucers" but I do not know what they were. Optical illusions appear to be out of the question, since both Mrs. [redacted] and I saw the phenomena clearly, and any sort of reflection likewise seems impossible.
