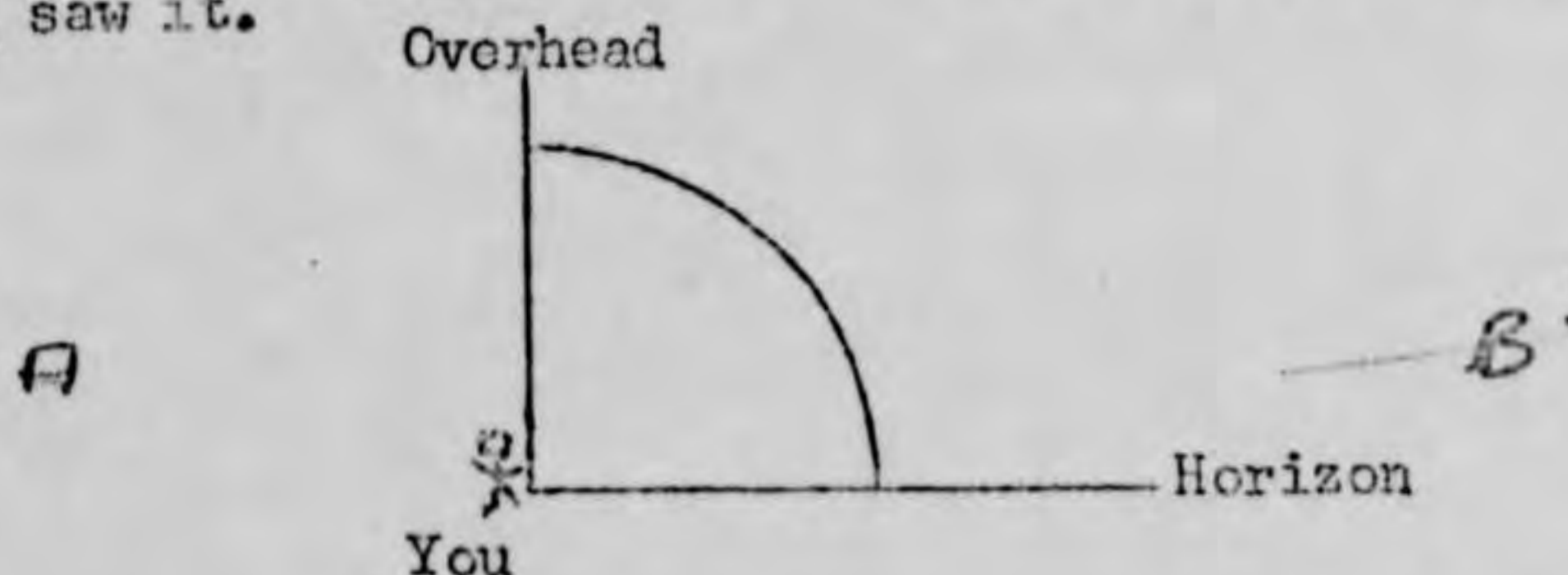

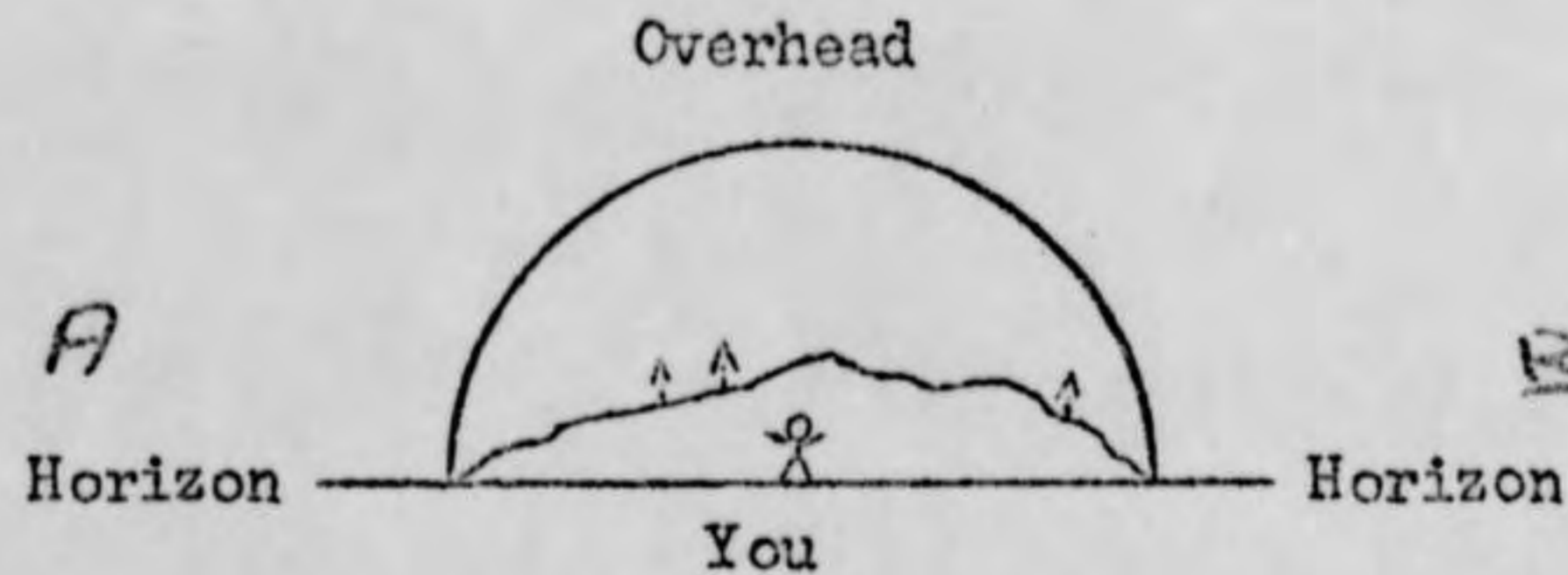

This observation was made under somewhat adverse conditions, by that I mean it was dark with out a moon.

The only means of seeing the object was by its flickering light. This light was going off and on with a regularity of a commercial airlines position light; which at first I believed it was. Its terrific speed ruled out that possibility.

There was no sound although the night was calm and background noises were at a minimum.

When I had plotted the course of the object I turned the observation of it over to my father while I phoned in my report. While under his observation object changed course to S.E. and stopped. It then took off and descended very rapidly.

Total time object was seen was between 2-3 minutes.
