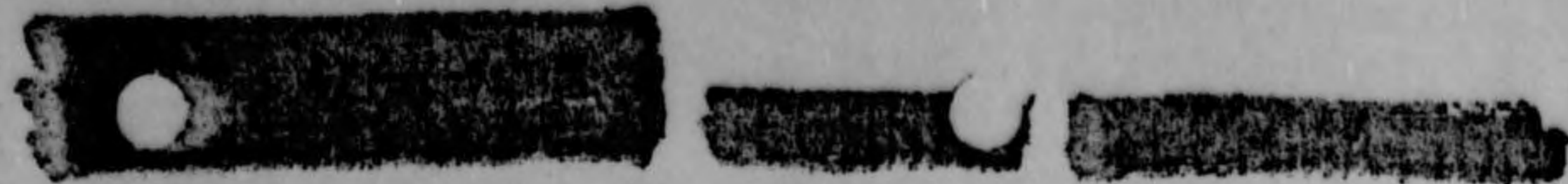

A report was received at O2101, 8 September 1952, from Baltimore Ground Observer Corps Filter Center stating that an unconventional Flying Object had been sighted at 0145, 8 September 1952. Object was described as a bright light flashing every sixty seconds, lasting approximately one to two seconds.

Object was sighted approximately five to fifteen miles east of Baltimore, Maryland.

Two fighter aircraft on combat air patrol were vectored to area and reported a flashing white light in southeast corner of Aberdeen Proving Grounds.
