1. Four or five unidentified flying objects were reported proceeding in a southerly direction at a great speed near Akureyri, on Iceland's north coast last Sunday, 26 October 1952 at about 0930L.
2. These objects had a spherical shape emitted neither sound nor flame, were clearly visible, and were under observation for two minutes.
3. Cloud bases were at 600-1000 meters, with no wind.
4. These objects were observed from two separate locations in Akureyri by three people. It is rumored that they were also later seen proceeding north.
5. This report was not transmitted electrically as the information is now three days old.
