## FLYING OBJECT REPORT

1. Three USAF non-coms, T/Sgt [redacted], [redacted] S/Sgt [redacted], and S/Sgt [redacted] assigned to this office on a [redacted] project, reported to the preparing officer the following information concerning a sighted flying object:

a. On 15 September 1952 at 1400 hours local time, visibility unlimited, Sgt [redacted] alone from a coordinate position of  $32^{\circ}45'40''E-39^{\circ}25'50''N$ , sighted a flying object, light grey in color, flying erratically approximately 15 miles horizontally east of viewing position at an estimated speed of 2000 miles per hour and at an estimated altitude of 15 miles.

The flying object was in Sgt. [redacted] vision for approximately two minutes and flew northwesterly from viewing position for an estimated distance of 15 miles before passing out of vision. No sound of engine or motor was heard and no vapor trail was seen. A description of flying object follows below:

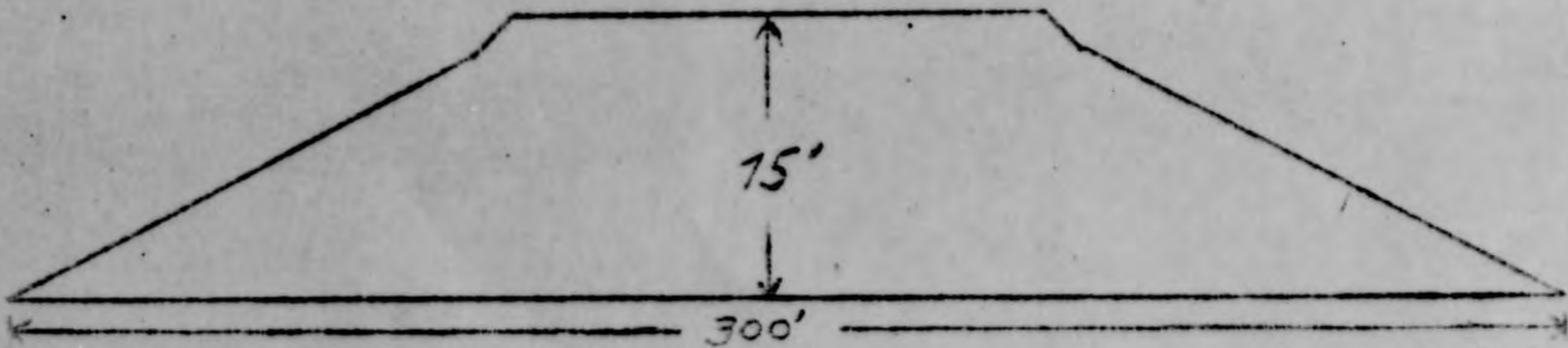
b. On 15 September, Sgt. [redacted] together with Sgts [redacted] and [redacted] from the above-stated coordinate position at 1420 hours, visibility unlimited, reported the following:

(1) The flying object was first seen by Sgt. [redacted] moving in a westerly direction from viewing position. Sgts. [redacted] and [redacted] saw the object, dark grey in color, 5 or 10 seconds later after the object started to gain flight momentum. The three sergeants together then saw the object fly in a southwesterly  $75^{\circ}$  arc from their viewing position for approximately two minutes before passing from vision at an estimated speed of 2000 miles per hour and at an estimated horizontal distance of 25 miles and at a 2<sup>nd</sup> mile estimated altitude.

(2) The size of the flying object was determined to be one-half the size of the viewer's thumb nail with arm fully extended towards object and thumb raised.

(3) No sound of engine or motor was heard and no vapor trail was seen during or after the sighting of flying object.

(4) All three sergeants described the configuration of the flying object as shown below:



The three sergeants [redacted] and [redacted] were [redacted] and [redacted] balloons and the flying object sighted was [redacted] and [redacted].
