- 1. Object appeared to be star like, only quite a bit larger, with a bluish, greenish color. It would fade and then grow brighter, or appeared to twinkle at times. Traveled slowly to the west from first sighting and moved up and down slightly while in flight. There was no sound, exhaust or any other unusual features.

 There was only one object seen. The shape was round as described by both observers. The altitude was unknown but guessed at about 3,000 ft.
- 2. Mr. first sighted the object about 110/102, he watched for quite a while then called the observation post an informed the observers on duty about 04202. Mr. lost sight of the object about 04302 after he had traveled about one (1) mile west of Laurel. The observer, Mr. lost watched the object from about 04252 till about 04502. He was on top of a two (2) story building which might account for the longer sighting.
- 3. The manner of observation was only by eye sight. Mr tried to contact the owner of a local observatory but was unable to, so couldn't look at the object through a telescope.
- 4. The location was approximately 108° 47' longitude, 45° 39' latitude, and followed this longitude west till out of sight. The observers were east of the object when it was first sighted.
- 5. Mr Earl Chief has about five (5) years in the Air Force. He was a Crew Chief and a Flight Engineer, and a Flying Officer for four (4) years. He is reliable and went to some length trying to get a better view of the object. Mr James Langth trying to get a better view of the object.
- 6. The weather was clear with a slight wind, possibly five (5) miles per hour with gusts from the west.
- 7. There appeared to be nothing meteorological that would have anything to do with the sighting.
- 8. There was no photographs taken and nothing found giving any physical evidence.
- 9. None
- 10. There was no serial activity at the time or during the sighting.






