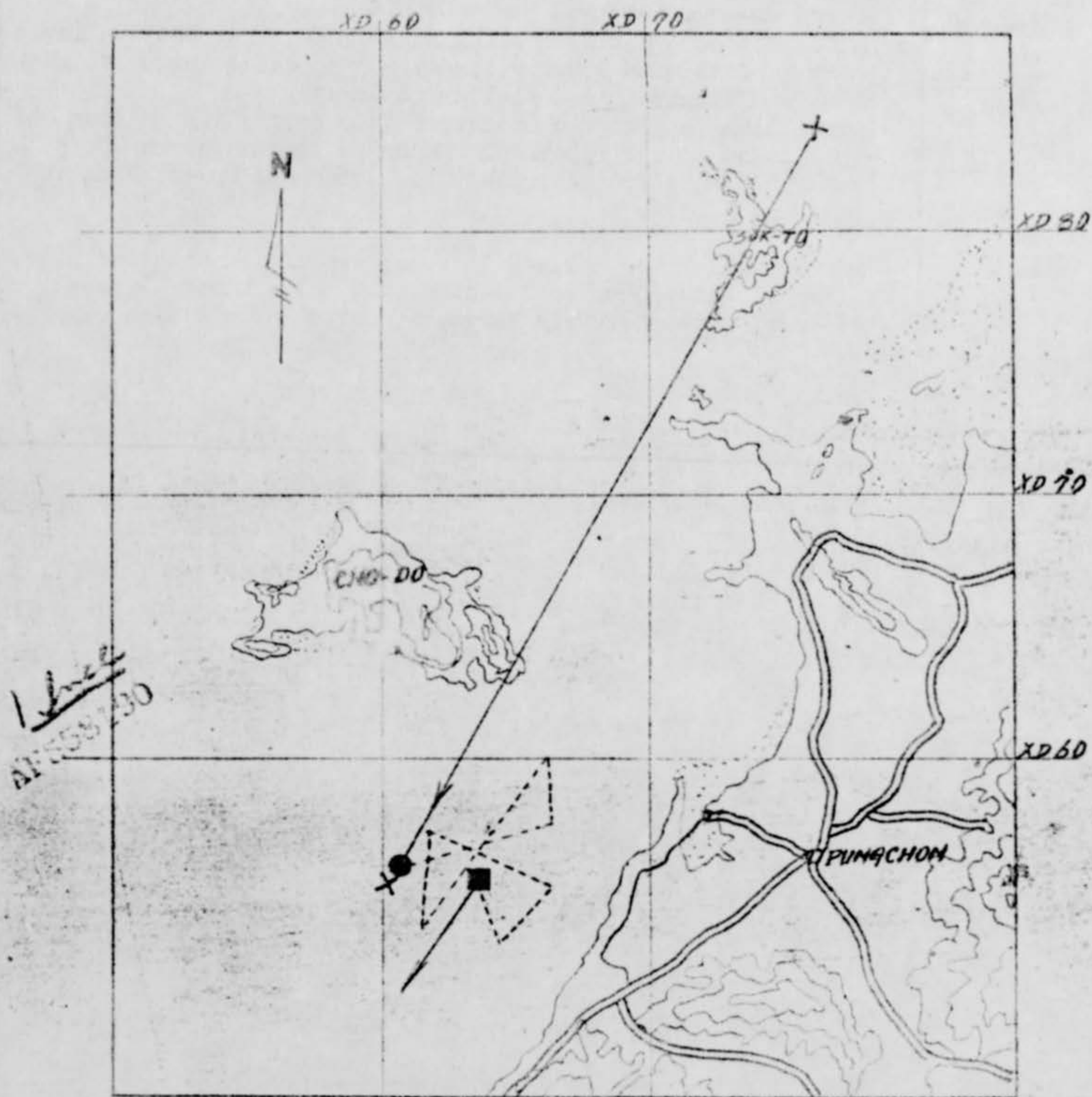

<p>6. TYPE OF OBSERVATION air visual</p>	<p>2. Bright light approached observers' a/c from a N direction on a collision course appearing dimmer as it came nearer. Obj turned E and accelerated rapidly to a high alt by climbing at an angle of 30 deg.</p>
<p>7. COURSE 1. SSE 2. S-E</p>	<p>COMMENTS: Check for balloon launches and a/c in area was made, negative results. Observers stated that obj was not a planet or astro body. Both observers have had considerable flying experience.</p>
