- 3. Re Mr. May 20, 1953, sighting in Los Angeles. He states this object descended and came to rest directly over his head at an altitude of five feet. We are sure Mr. Whis at least five feet tall, give or take a couple of inches, in which case it would have been sitting on his head. The object remained motionless for about five minutes at this altitude. It was described as the exact size of a "night football." It must not have frightened him because it wasn't reported until the latter part of 1954.



I am naturally curious whath r or not my experiouses, which I proviously reported to you, have ever both of any use or alt.



I would like to report, as a matter of official record, an occurrence that I believe may be of some interest, at least as a matter of official record.

In Sacramento, California, on about November 15, 1952, it was my privilege to witness the appearance of a white stone in the sky at a height of about 100 feet. The time was about 3 p.m. and it was a clear day. As soon as Lookserved this white stone it moved across the sky in an easterly direction at a very rapid rate and dissapreared. This observation was made in the rear of my residence at 4800

Cibola way in Sacremento.

of Los Angeles, it was my privilege to observe descending over my head, apparently the same white stone. The time was about 9.a.m. and it was a clear, sunny day. The stone descended from almost directly overhead and slightly from the Northwest. It came to rest abruptly over my head at about five(5) feet altitude and obviously was controlled in some way. It's exact size was almost identical to a night football and this was what it at first reminded me of for its appearance and dimension were about the same except that it was pure white and there were no marking upon it of any kind.

As soon as it had halted above my head, (I did not take my eyes from it), a small white cloud gathered slowly about it from the surrounding a atmosphere. This was very unusual because the cloud was created from nothing at all and drawn together as though with some electrical force. There was a slight smell of sweet perfume in the air at the time.

The stone and cloud remained above my head for a period of about five (5) minutes and then very slowly ascended upwards until out of sight. Its ascension was slow requiring about 3 or 4

minutes.

Because of the nature of this observation I believe that you might desire to have this information at hand since a collection of such information may help you in solving the appearance of other unexplained phenomena sighted by other persons.

My 201 file is available to you and my training in anti-aircraft observation is a

matter of record.

I hereby swear this to be true under my oath as an officer of the Air Forces of The United States.

Please inform me if you receive this communication. I suspect a higher intalligence to be indicated for ouvious reasons though any practical reason escapes me.
