7. COURSE NE	REMARKS: Venus is visible at this time in the E and it is believed that source saw Venus but this does not explain the other two objects. Venus 6 hrs 14 min, 70 deg azimuth 17 deg elevation. Jupiter 5 hrs 14 min, 85 deg azimuth, 25 deg elevation. Betelgeuse, 90 deg azimuth 17 deg elevation. Capella, 60 deg azimuth, 40 deg elevation. Mars 8 hrs 13 min, rising at 0345. Venus & Betelgeuse at same altitude. Jupiter 15 deg to right and higher, all objects would disappear with dawn.



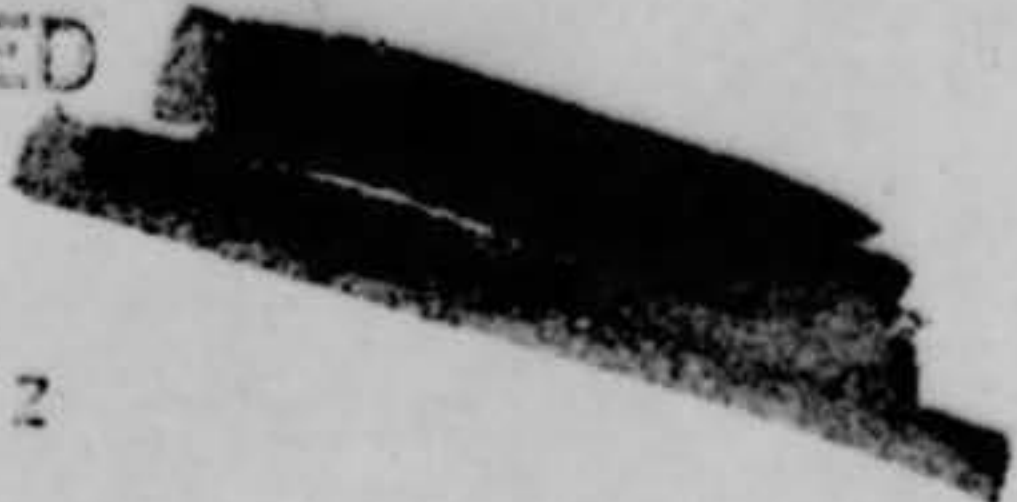
