"FLYCBRPT TRIANGULAR OBJECT NO SIZE ESTIMATE YELLOW ONE THIN COMPARED TO WIDTH NOT VISIBLE EXHAUST CAPABLE OF SLOW FLT AND RAPID ACCELERATION APPROACHED CITY OF HAYWARD CALIF FROM DIRECTION OF OAKLAND CALIF AT RELATIVE SLOW SPEED.
