Capt. Theodoros J. Caracalas, Master of the Panamanian SS.
Thekla, reports that on a voyage from Europe toward Korea on
October 12, 1953, at 0020 (ship's time) he sighted Minikoi Island
Light (Intl. No. F0758) (approximate position 8°16' N., 73°01'
E.) at a distance of approximately 60 miles.

Weather overcast, wind easterly force 2 to 3.
