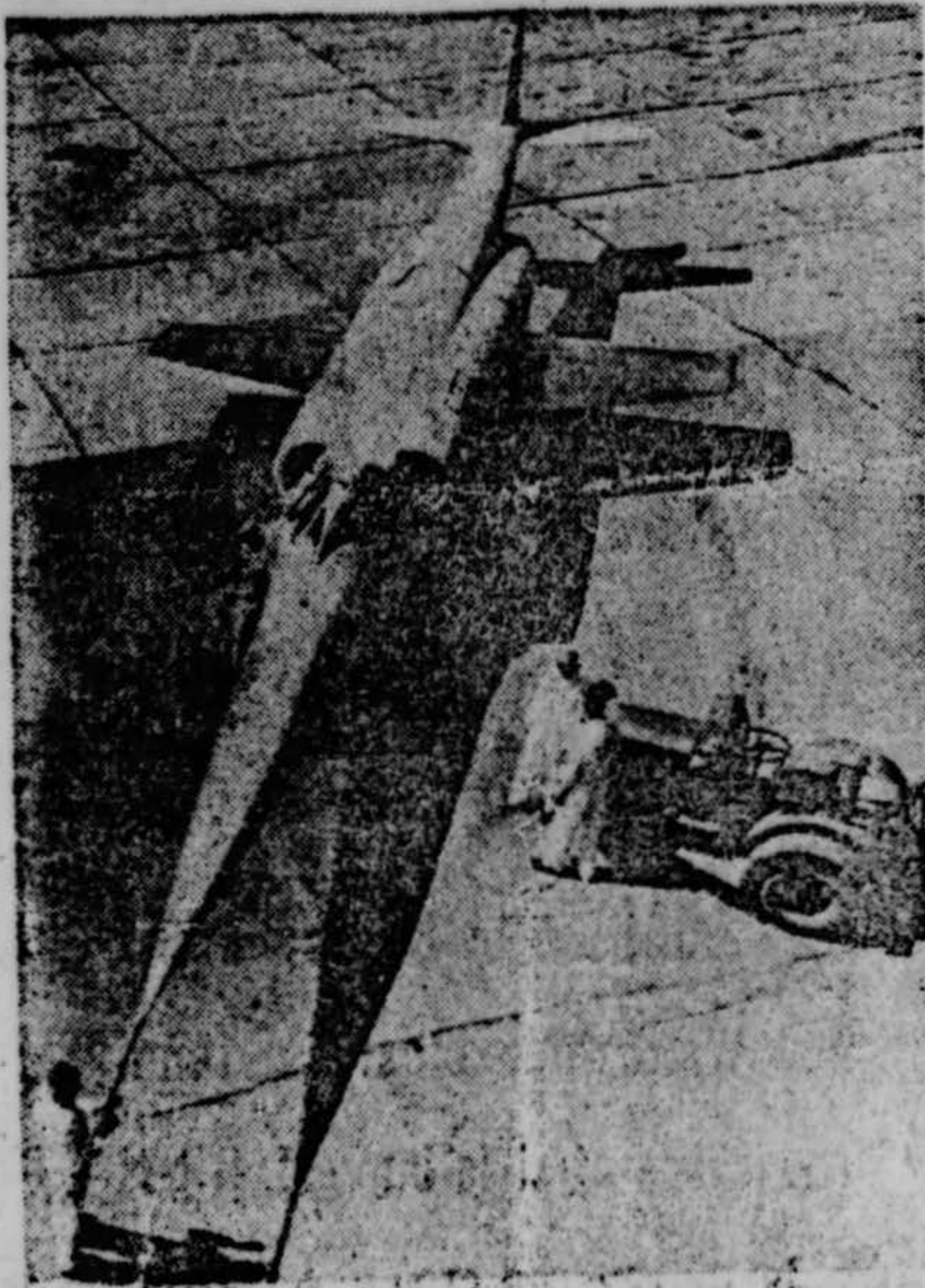

The Air Force last night released this first photo of the "Flying Stiletto," dagger-shaped research plane designed to fly at 2,000 miles an hour.

A. E. Displays 'Flying Stiletto'

WASHINGTON, Nov. 16 (AP).—The Air Force cautiously lifted the secrecy curtain today from its "flying stiletto," a dagger-shaped research plane designed to fly 2,000 miles an hour at extremely high altitudes.

The jet-propelled craft, the X-3, was built by Douglas Aircraft Co. under sponsorship of the Air Force, Navy and National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics. It has been tested at Edwards Air Force Base, Calif., for a year but little has been said about its radical shape.

The X-3 resembles nothing else now flying. It has a long, sharply tapered nose and stubby straight wings. It is 66 feet 9 inches long over all, but its wing is a mere 22 feet 8 inch

air-line transport. But its wing span is less than that of the tail of a DC-3.
