## 3 States Report Flash in Sky

A flery object, tentatively identified by astronoms as a meteor, flashed over section of New York State, Pennsylvania, Ohio. and southern Canada at dawn yesterday, startling hundreds of persons, many of whom notified police and airport officials.

The object was seen about 7 a. m. at such widely separate points as Marietta, Ohio; Ottawa and Troy, N. Y. Witnesses described it variously as meteor, a burning airplane, an airplane flare, a lightning bolt, a sheet of fire; an are light and a ball of fire. It was not known if the

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
