
The date was May 24, 1954, the time was 5:00 P.M. I was sitting on my front porch with my friends. Something made me look up (which I always do when I am outside). I saw a silvery projectile, tube-like something. I kept my eye on it for about 3 minutes as my friends did too. The object stayed motionless and that's when I decided to get a picture of it, I hopped on my friend's bike and rode as fast as I could to a drug store where I live. I bought 1 roll of film for my baby brownie camera, I stood out in front of the store and took 3 pictures, people came near me and asked what I was taking a picture of in the sky. So they looked up to and saw it. The object ~~was~~ stayed there, moving South East very slowly against the wind. ~~It~~

So I bought another roll of film and took 8 more pictures of an enclothing some pictures which you can inspect and see for yourself that I am not lying. I will also enclose drawings that I made while observing the disks thru my telescope, they are ~~off~~ of actual size as I have seen them. The first two are five minutes apart and the rest are about 45 seconds to 1 minute apart. The ~~the~~ full time of the sighting was from 5:00 o'clock P.M. to about 7:00 P.M.. The disks change color as I <sup>was</sup> observing them, from a pure white in the center of the disk and an orange corona at its edge, then they change color right before my eyes to a yellow and the orange edge did not change color. And this is not the reflection from the setting sun which the sun turns the sky to yellow while setting the sun was still very high up. As I was observing the disks thru my telescope another one came into view ~~which~~ which might have been flying parallel with the two tip somers ~~in~~ move slightly behind the ~~other~~ than they changed their course from S.E. to South, then they vanish.

from.


P.S. I hope very much that you will be satisfied

top edge






Same disk
