WAS THE SECOND QUOTE "FLYING SAUCER", UNQUOTE, THAT SHE HAS SEEN IN THE PAST 3 YRS. SHE STATED SHE SAW THE FIRST ONE WHILE AT A DRIVE-IN THEATER AND IT WAS IDENTICAL IN COLORING AND PERFORMANCE; HOWEVER, SHE STATED IT WAS CONSIDERABLY CLOSER TO HER DUE TO ITS TREMENDOUS SIZE. SHE ESTD THE SIZE OF THE FIRST UFGC TO BE $1\frac{1}{2}$ THE SIZE OF THE DRIVE-IN MOVIE SCREEN. THE CHILDREN WHO OBSERVED THIS REPT UFGC WERE EXTREMELY FRIGHTNED AND EXCITED BY THE SIGHTING. POSSIBILITY EXISTS THAT THE FALLING LIGHTS WERE FLARES DROPPED BY A COGARD ACFT DURING NIGHT-OPERATIONS TNG. WHILE THIS TYPE OF TNG IS PERIODICALLY CONDUCTED IN THIS AREA, LOCAL USCG OFFS STATED THEY WERE NOT AWARE OF ANY SUCH TNG BEING CONDUCTED AT THE TIME OF THE REPORTED SIGHTING.
