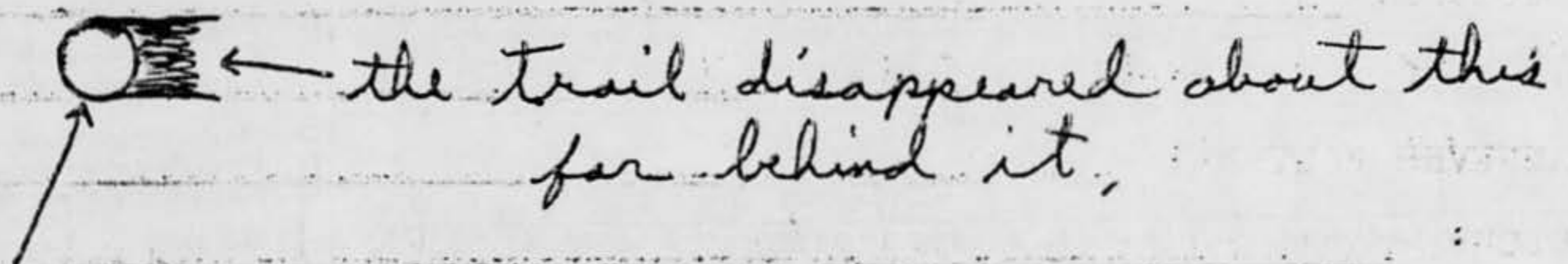

Color silver-white with black center. 3 to 4 times as bright as the moon. The object started at the zenith and traveled to the NW for about 10 deg then disappeared. Left trail behind.		11. COMMENTS Insufficient data for analysis. Distance travel not included. Possible meteor, possible jet with afterburner.	

The UFO started at the zenith and traveled to the N.W. for about 10° then disappeared.

The UFO left a trail behind it which looked like a jet vapor trail ~~behind it~~ during the daytime.



It had a black center which was outlined with a silver color.
