AT THE TIME FOR THE INITIAL SIGHTING IT WAS REPORTED TO BE IN THE COMPANY OF A MUCH LARGER OBJECT WHICH DISAPPEARED BEFORE THE OBSERVER COULD GET AN ACCURATE DESCRIPTION. ITS METHOD OF DISAPPEARANCE WAS UNNOWN. SSSINCE ALMOST NO INFORMATION CONCERNING THE LARGER OBJECT COULD BE FURNISHED BY MR. INDRED THIS REPORT WILL COVER ONLY THE SMALL OBJECT. THE OBJECTS WERE FIRST OBSERVED AT PASCO,

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WASH. BY MAND A GRUOUP OF OTHER PERSONS. (MR DID NOT NOW THE EXACT NUMBER OF PEOPLE NEITHER DID HE FURNISH NAMES AND ADDRESSES). SOMEONE IN THE GROUP PROCURED A PAIR OF BINACULARS AND ALL INFORMATION FURNISHED BY MR. WAS BASED ON HIS OBSERVATION OF THE OBJECT THROUGH THE BINOCULARS. HE REPORTED THAT HE FIRST SIGHTED THE OBJECT AS PASCO, WASH AND FURTHER OBSERVED IT FOR A PERIOD OF APPROXIMATELY SIX (6) HOURS ALONG THE ROUTE OF THE NORTHERN PACIFIC RR WHILE THE TRAIN WAS ENROUTE TO SPOKANE, WASH. THE POSITION OF THE OBJECT WHEN FIRST SIGHTED WAS ESTIMATED TO BE AT APPROXIMATELY P,000 FEET ALTITUDE AT A DISTANCE ESTIMATED TO BE APPROX 30 MILES WEST, SOUTHWEST OF PASCO. THE OBJECT WAS NOT MOVING BUT REMAINED IN A STATIONARY POSITION. MR ESTIMATED THE SIZE OF THE OBJECT TO BE ABOUT THE SAME AS THAT OF CESSNA 170 IRCRAFT WHEN OBSERVED AT AN ALTITUDE OR DISTANCE OF 1500 FEET. THE OBJECT APPEARED TO HAVE STRAIGHT WINGS POSITIONED MIDWAY BETWEEN THE NOSE AND THE TAIL. NO VERTICAL OR HORIZONTAL STABILIZER WAS VISIBLE. THERE APPEARED TO BE NO TRACE OF AN EXHAUST AND NO SOUND WAS HEARD. AS STATED THE OBJECT REMAINED STATIONARY (DESCRIBED BY INDRED AS APPEARING AS AN AIRCRAFT IN A TIGHT BANKN THIS WAS TRUE THROUGHOUT THE SIGHTING EXCEPT FOR ONE MOVE NOTED WHEN THE OBJECT WAS FIRST OBSERVED. THIS MOVE WAS IN A

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STRAIGHT LINE AND COVERED ABOUT ONE QUARTER OF THE VISIBLE SKY. AFTER COMPLETING THIS MOVE AT AN EXTREMELY HIGH SPEED THE OBJECT RETURNED TO ITS ORIGINAL POSITION. THE SKY WAS CLEAR DURING THE PERIOD OF THE XSERVATION. VISIBILITY WAS UNLIMITED. NO PHOTOGRAPHS WERE TAKEN. THE OBSERVER COMPANY IS A PRIVATE PILOT WITH APPROX-IMATELY100 HOURS FLYING TIME INNSINGLE-ENGINE AIRCRAFT. AT APPROXIMATELY THE SAME TIME OF THIS SIGHTING AN OBSERVATION OF AN OBSERVATION OF AN UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECT WAS REPORTED TO THE SPOKANE FILTER CENTER BY CONTENT WASH. DETAILS OF THE SIGHTING WERE NOT AVAILABLE AT THE TIME OF THIS REPORT BUT THE OBJECT WAS SIGHTED IN THE SAME GEOGRAPHICAL AREA AND IN ABOUT THE SAME POSITION.
