- (2) Description of course of object (a):
 - (a) Initially visible only because of a well called observer's attention to it.

 - (d) FLM, in horizontal plane, frequently changing direction 30 degrees, disappearing on the horizon to the southwest.
 - (e) Low incandescent form object seemed to "roll away" as it came toward the horizon. Appears to be traveling at a very high rate of speed.
