OBJECT WAS BLUE STREAM OF LIGHT SIGHTED DIRECTLY AHEAD OF ACFT, THEN STREAMED THRU 3D CPG AFB, TWISTED TWO SMALL EXPLOSIONS & DISAPPEARED IN ONE LARGE EXPLOSION OF BRIGHT BLUE LIGHT. CAVU. SIGHTED BY MAJ W.W. JENKINS, SENIOR NAVIGATOR, IN ASTRO DOME AT TIME OF SIGHTING. OFFICER IS MEMBER OF 42ND AIR TRANSPORT SQUADRON, ANDREWS AFB, MD. BEARING OF ACFT 194 TRU. ACFT WAS FLYING FROM SONDRESTROM TO GOOSE. OBJECT ON LEVEL & TRAVELING FROM EAST TO WEST. OBSERVER ESTIMATED DISTANCE TO OBJECT APPROX 10 MILES, BUT DIFFICULT BECAUSE LACK OF REF POINTS. OBSERVER STATED OBJECT ACTED LIKE FLARE BUT ~~ANOTHER~~ ACFT IN VICINITY ~~DO~~ ONLY COLOR WAS BRIGHT BLUE. NO NOISE. JENKINS LEFT GOOSE IMMEDIATELY AFTER INTERROGATION FOR WESTOVER AFB, FINAL DESTINATION IS HOME STATION ANDREWS AFB.
