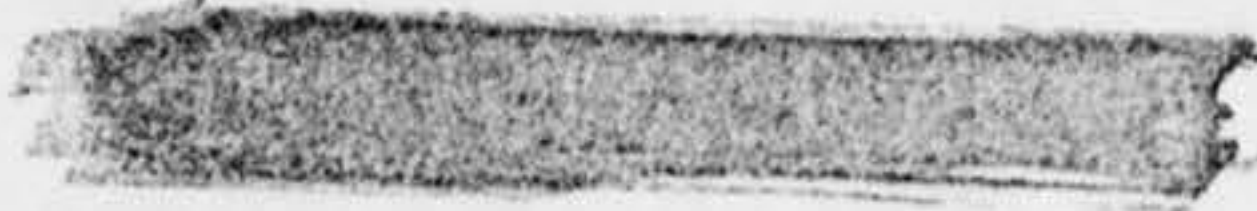

- a. Rectangular when viewed at 90 degrees; cylindrical when viewed from rear of object.
 - b. Length 12-15 feet; width 5 feet.
 - c. Leading portion of object was the color of bright light changing to orange toward the rear.
 - d. Two.
 - e. Two lights appeared to be on the same horizontal plane with an estimated 15 feet between them. Observers stated that the two lights were either coming from one object, or two objects flying in a tight formation.

As a result of the interview and interrogation of the observers named in para 6b, it is my opinion that an unusual flying object was seen by both men. There was no indication that either party possessed a high degree of imagination or tendency to exaggerate or fabricate the data submitted. Due to the unexpected appearance of the object(s) and the short time observed, the accuracy of the descriptive data is somewhat questionable.</p> <p>b. Preliminary investigation with AWC and Control Tower agencies gave no indication that the observation made was caused by scheduled aircraft or weather phenomena.</p>
