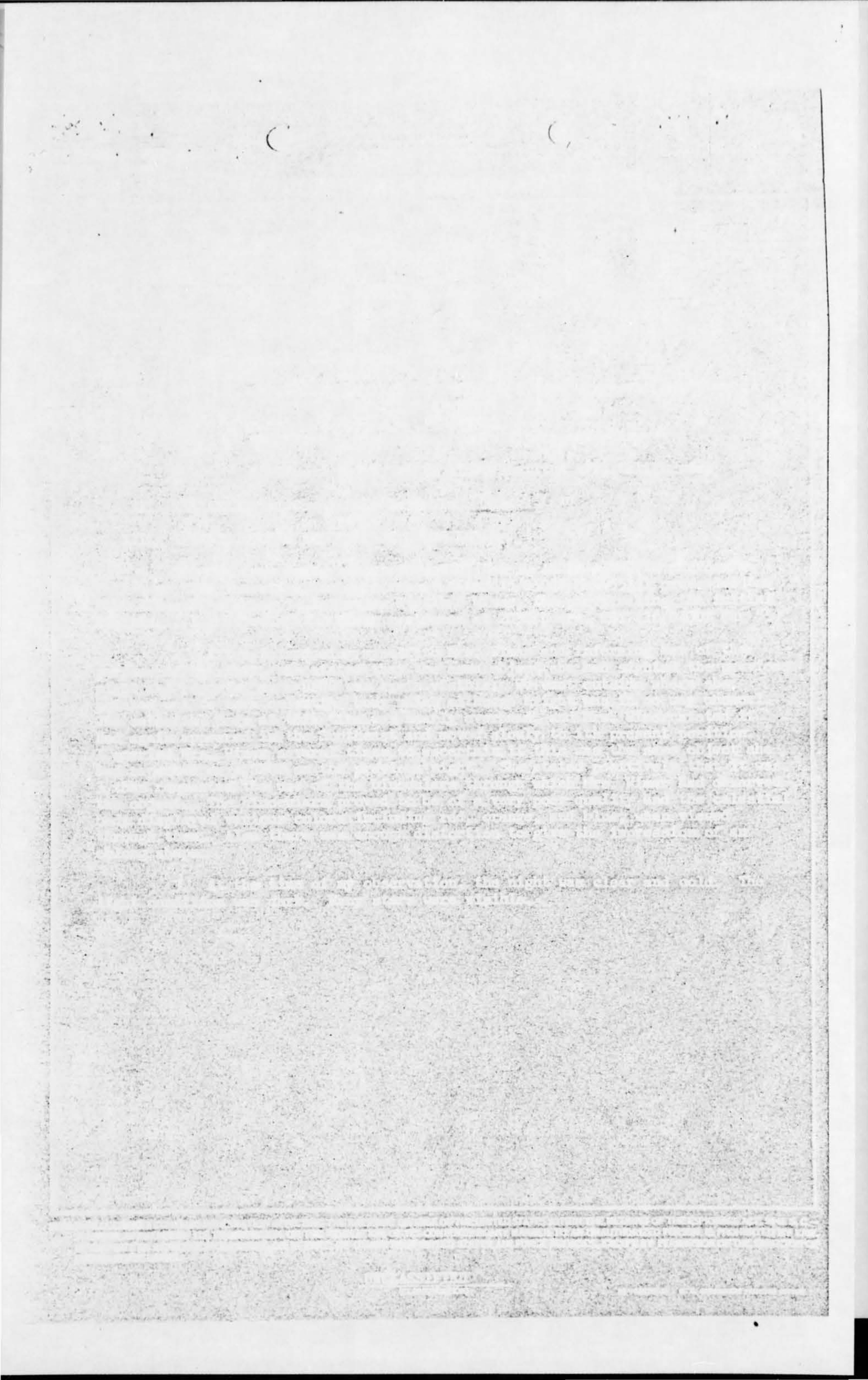
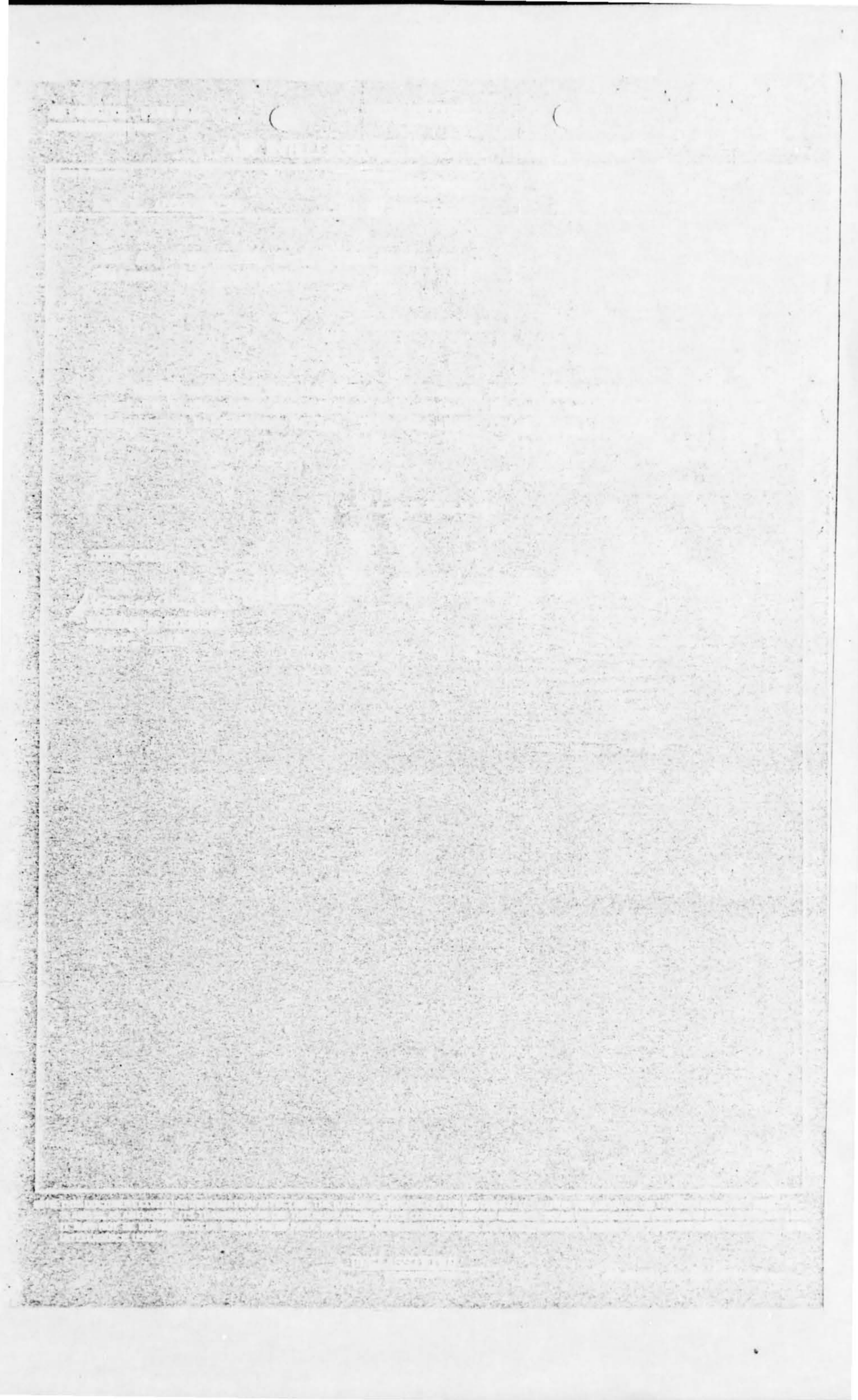

Observer observed object thru eight by fifty (8x50) binoculars. Clouds starting at three thousand (3,000) feet.		11. COMMENTS Two (2) separate reports were received on this sighting and both reports contradicted each other on some data, i.e., size, color. Both reports from the same source. A limited phone out investigation was conducted with/significant results. The cause of this sighting is unknown. No correlation with radar or weather. A low flying civilian aircraft was reported at Redford, Oregon at an altitude of 5,000 feet, heading south-west. Time: Unk.

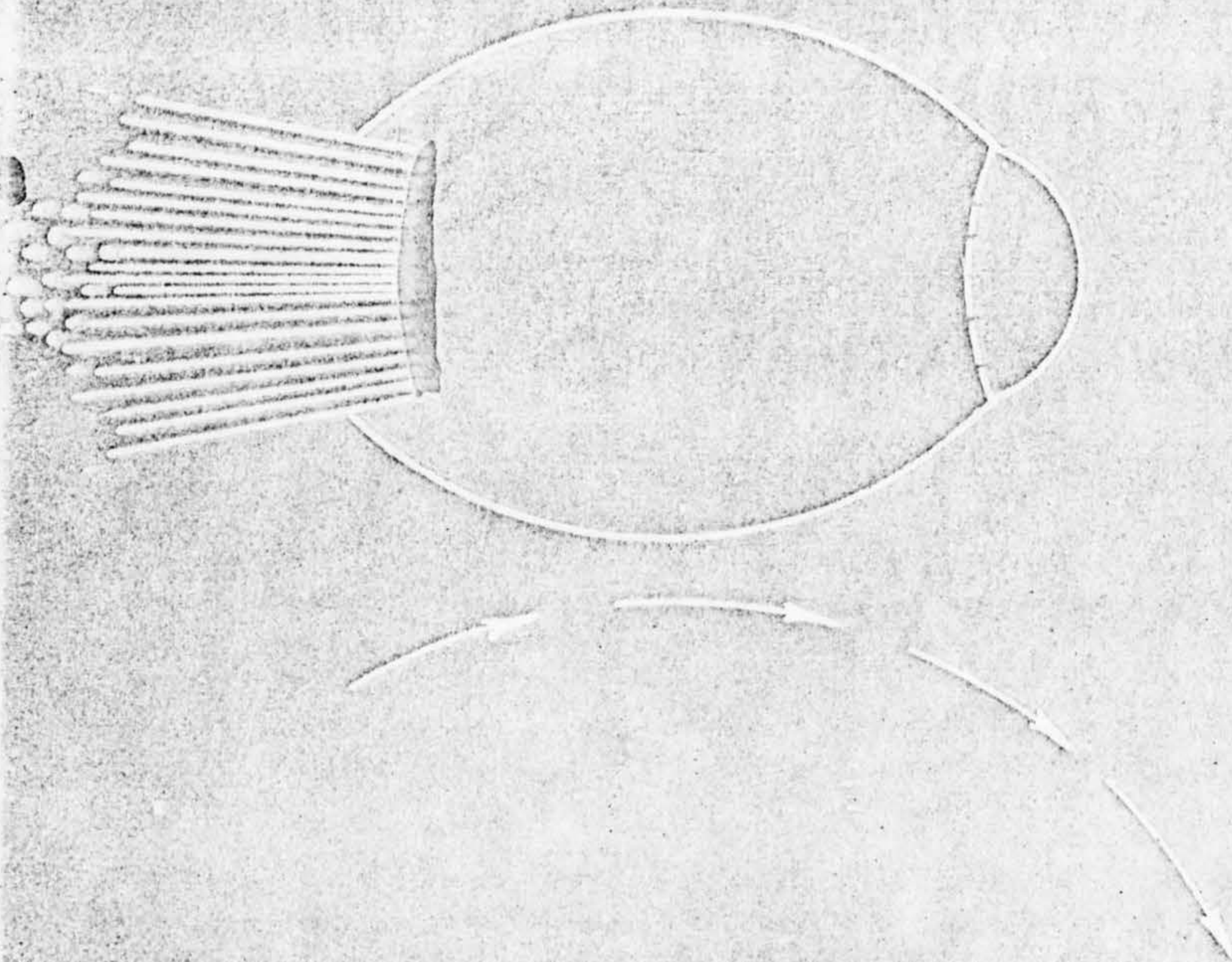
