He observed it for an undisclosed time, after which the object seemed to fade away.		11. COMMENTS Azimuth of sighting indicated in report lies in direction of air navigation beacon of rotating type. Color reported red and white corresponds to usual color of airways beacons. The age of observer and short duration of sighting preclude any sort of follow-up investigation. Conclusions: Probably airway beacon.
