Then suddenly two or three of 6 round bright white objects appeared in sky across moon at 300-350 ft up at an angle over a window.

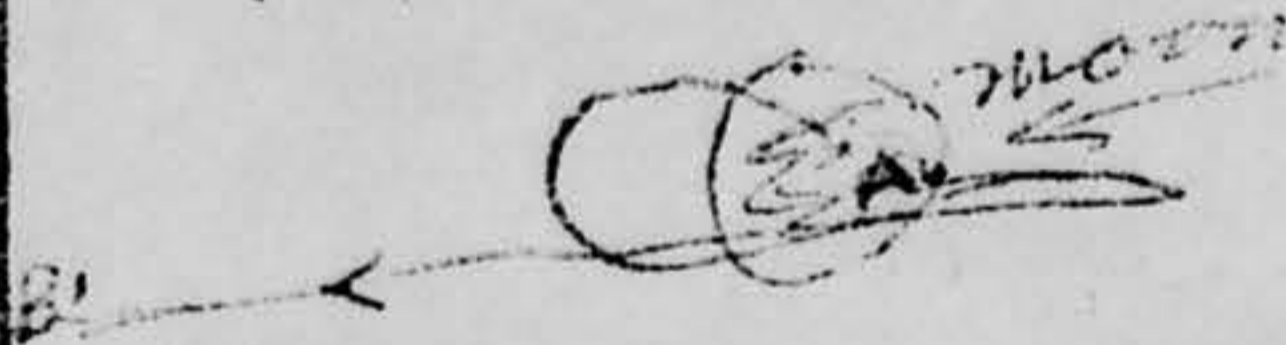

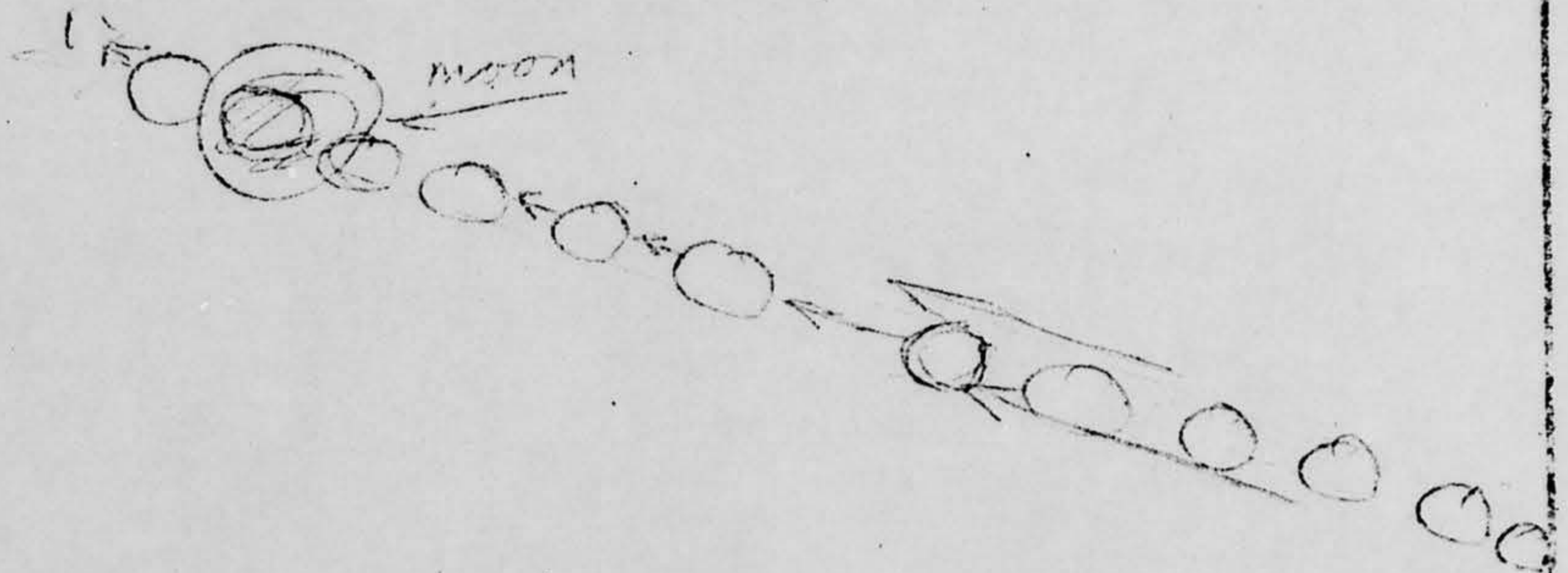
