BRIEF SUMMARY OF SIGHTING <p>One (1) shapeless object, changing from red to white to red, the size of a star at a distance, appeared 50 miles east of GOC post and disappeared into the dense fog two hours later. Weather: Clear with no clouds, visibility; night unlimited. The object while viewed appeared to flicker up and down but remained in the east for the time of sighting. Observers report two (2) aircraft passed near object at different times, aircraft not picked up by radar.</p>		11.
