The noise attracted the observer's attention.</b>			11. COMMENTS  <b>The age of the observer would limit the observer's knowledge of objects which would be readily identifiable to the trained layman. In all probability the source saw a conventional aircraft (Probably jet), which reflecting the sunlight, gave the disc-shaped appearance. The fact that the object sounded like a jet and the noise of the object first attracted the observer's attention, leads to the above checked conclusion.</b>
