Object was observed visually for twenty-three minutes and left area of observation with tremendous burst of speed. Halo effect remained after disappearance.		<b>11. COMMENTS</b> On the basis that object was observed overhead for 23 minutes with erratic movements - possibly balloon. Winds not given. Disappearance and halo attributed to balloon burst.
