Object was observed visually for 40 to 45 seconds.		
<b>11. COMMENTS</b> No significant astro body in North descending. Capella at 030dgr rising fm 5dgr elevation to 10dgr during sighting. Not moving as balloon would be expected to move. Possibly searchlight on haze layer. Not sufficient data for evaluation.
