Obj was initially sighted at 45 dgr elevation, 135dgr azimuth & moved on a straight flight path to 45dgr elevation, 35dgr azimuth. Obj was observed visually & through binoculars for 20 minutes. Sources stated that obj reappeared at 0256Z, moved in same direction as before, was seen for 4 minutes & disappeared behind buildings. No Report In File.		11. COMMENTS Note this is third sighting fm Cunningham area (others in Aug). Description of sighting indicates on, /first sighting to be balloon. Shape, size, light, duration, course, & wind direction tend to support balloon as cause. Second sighting not believed to be related to first due to short duration & disappearance behind building. Second sighting probably aircraft.
