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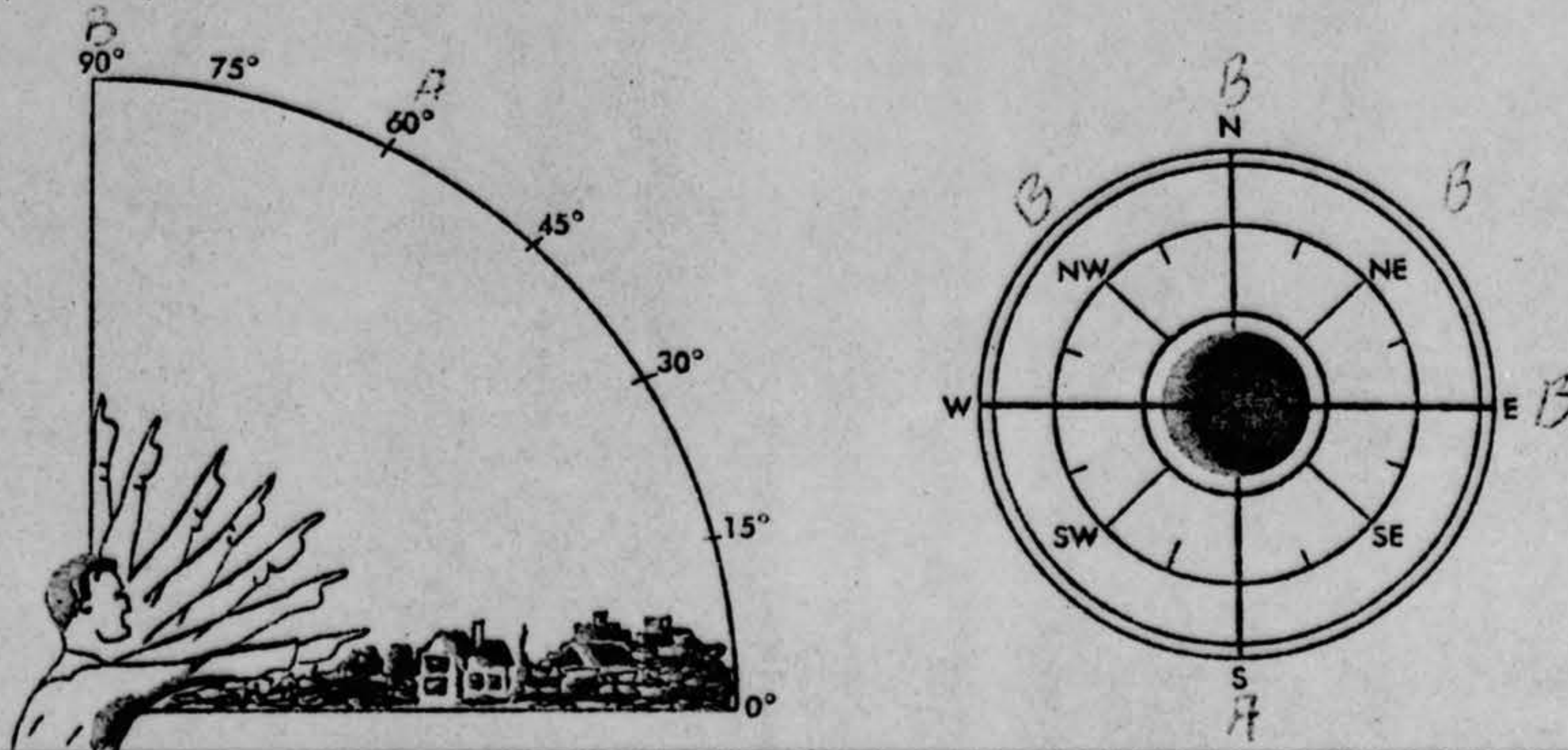
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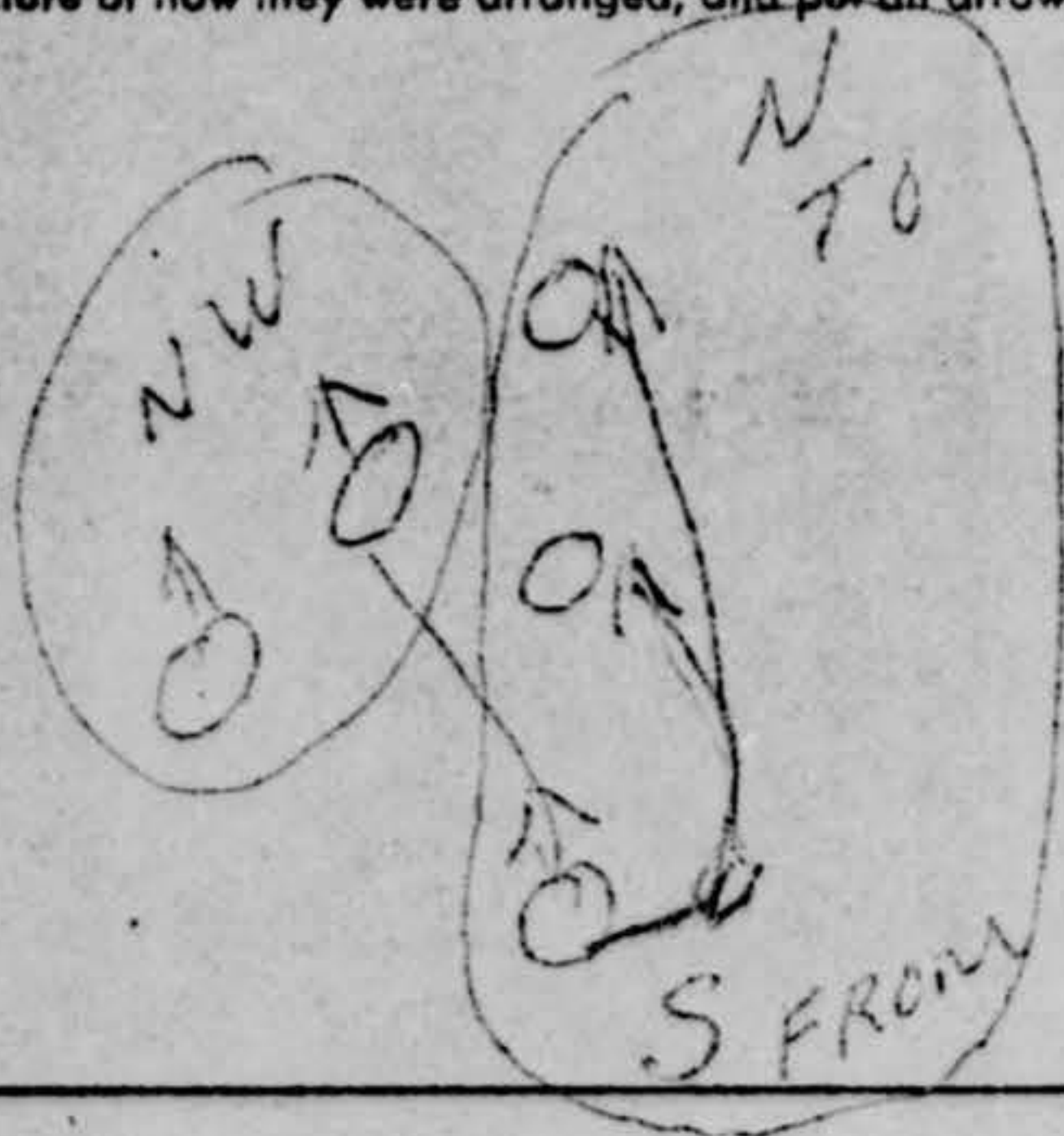

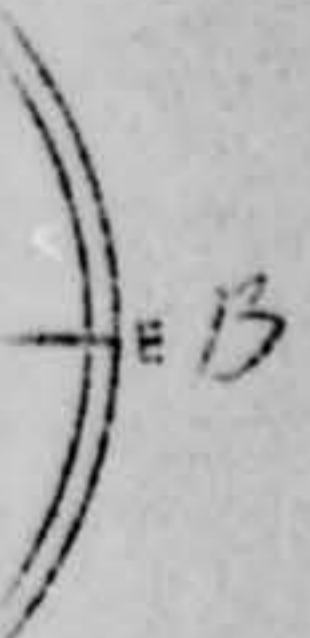

I observed (5 vehicles) in all! I choose the word vehicle due to my own thoughts. These objects were certainly in control at all times, By whom or what, I do not know. I do know, they were being operated under control. I decided on the altitude by comparison with stars, operating altitudes of airlines & military aircraft. Radar operator at Selfridge at time I called him, said they had extensive night flying missions at the time. I told him quote, If he could show me the aircraft that could make a 90° Right angle turn at flank speed I would eat every rivet in it! He did say, they had some encounters with Bogie Blips. That is all he would say. I consider myself to be a logical person in every respect. I have had 5 complete medical exams in five years for the I.C.C. I even will drive a truck

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For ~~me~~ me, it doesn't bother me one iota to tell people what I observed, I know what I saw with my own eyes! I shut off my engine, got right out of the truck. These objects passed right over me. Silently, no vapor no change in speed till later, I compared their speed to the movement of Echo I. I estimated it to be half the speed of our Ballon. This Brilliance was about equal, The only real change in appearance was when trailing object increased speed to gain two leading objects heading N.W. This was the one I could detect faint sparks of orange Red from TOP center, myself & 20 other drivers observed these objects on this night. At this time I was employed as a (Test Driver) for Ford mts co. High speed driving was a common thing. I have a good estimate in other words by speed & distance. These things were fantastic, If I may & I will, I am going to enclose a separate sheet.
