untill Dec. 2 with busiest days: Nov. 16, 27, 30 & Dec. 2) There  
were at least 85 Reports in 25 days, reports A.P.R.G.!

ON THE NIGHT OF 17-18 NOVEMBER 1956, THE STAFF DUTY OFFICER ON DUTY  
THIS HEADQUARTERS RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING TELEPHONE REPORTS. 2136  
MOUNTAIN STANDARD TIME - FROM KORPI AT STATE POLICE RADIO STATION.  
QUOTE "AIRCRAFT SIGHTED AT ABOUT 1000 FEET JUST WEST OF ABERDEEN,  
SOUTH DAKOTA. ALSO SIGHTED FIVE TO TEN MILES WEST OF REDFIELD. DIM RED  
GLOW, CHANGING TO BRIGHT RED GLOW. OBJECT HOVERED AND THEN MOVED TO  
ANOTHER LOCATION. SIGHTED BY A FARMER AT 2150 CENTRAL STANDARD TIME  
AND BY STATE POLICE OFFICERS NUMBER  AND  AT ABOUT THE SAME TIME."
