Object was first seen at 20 dgr elevation, 330 dgr azimuth, and disappeared at 10 dgr elevation 90 dgr azimuth. Object was seen traveling in a SE direction. Object appeared to roll as it approached the far end of flight path. Object was seen visually for 3 to 5 minutes.		11.
