1. SNAKEHIPS REPORTED THAT RINGBOLT 54, A B-47 FLYING AT 37,000 FT, SIGHTED A LONG GREEN FLAME COMING FROM SOME "Local" OBJECT FLYING OVER LIVINGSTON MONTANA AT 2140 MST ON 1 AUG 1957 AT 33,000 FT PD

2140 over Livingston, (Chart 268, KA quadrant)

2. THERE WAS NO TRACE OF DAYLIGHT PD RINGBOLT 54 WAS OVER LIVINGSTON MONTANA AT TIME OF SIGHTING PD CLOUD CONDITION WAS THICK.

WEATHER WAS DRY. THERE WAS A SLIGHT BREEZ. TEMPERATURE WAS WARM.
