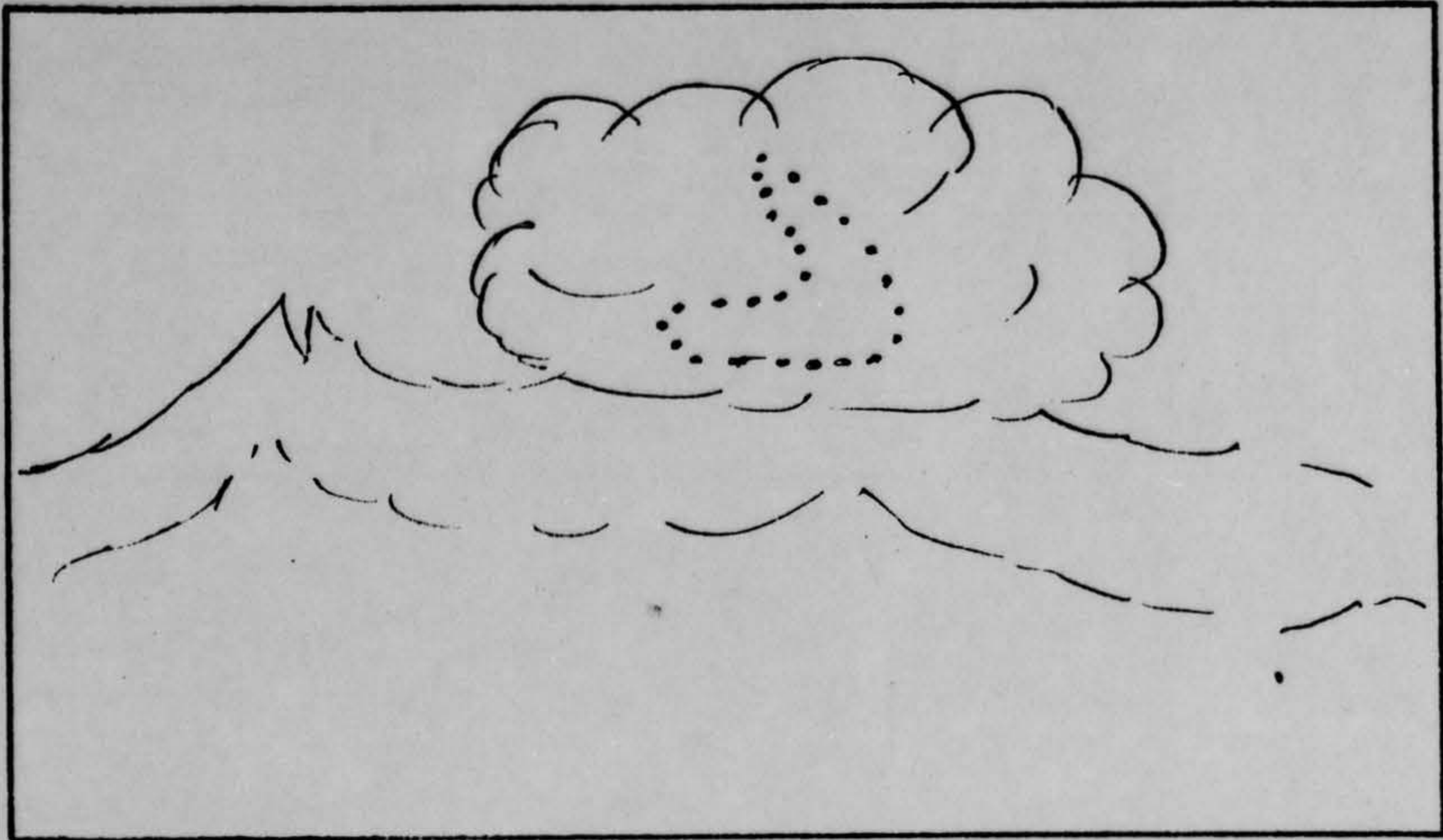


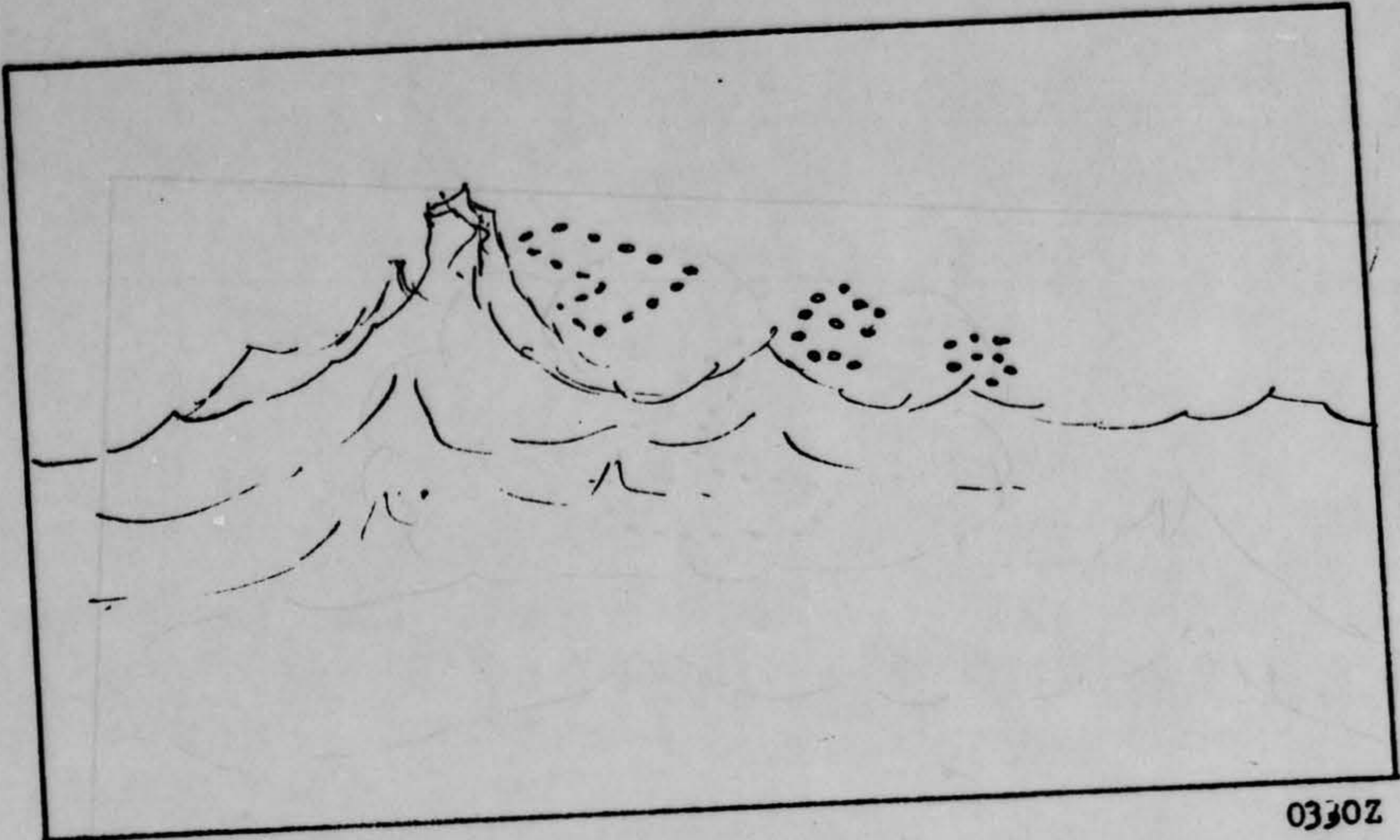

1. Description of objects:

- a. Shape: Formation of lights and a ball-shaped object. *was seen on a dark night*
- b. Size: Ball-shaped object approximately size of finger tip in relation to background of mountains.
- c. Color: Lights and ball both bluish-white. Third flight believed to be a pinkish glow. *As seen on a dark night*
- d. Unable to estimate number.
- e. Formation: First and second sightings - wedge formation. Third sighting formation went from wedge to a Y or straight line (disagreement between observers) and then into a ball-shaped formation.
- f. No discernable features or details.
- g. No tail, trail, or exhaust.
- h. No sound.
- i. Other pertinent features: Lights spaced proportionately from each other. First two flights appeared to move faster than last flight.

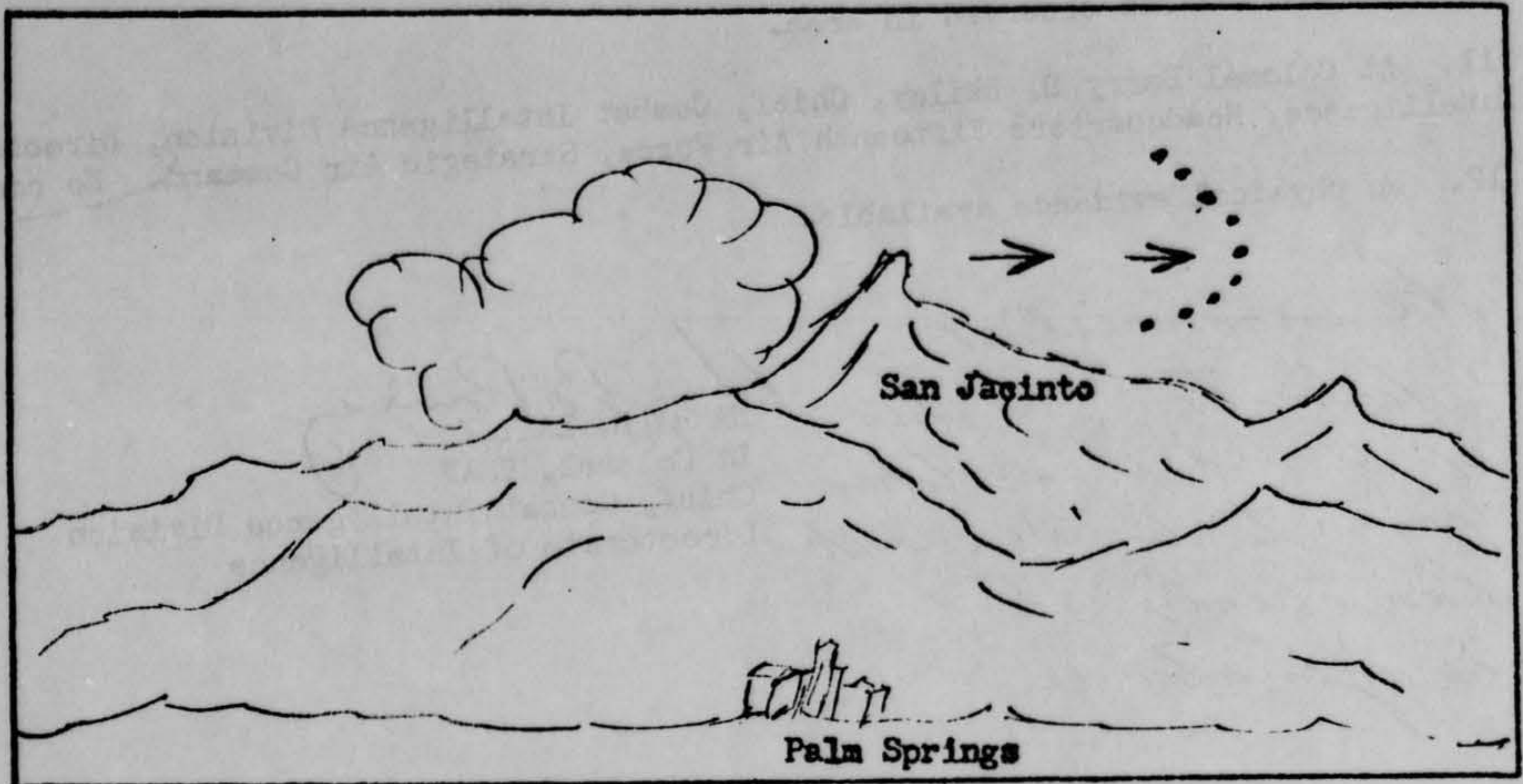

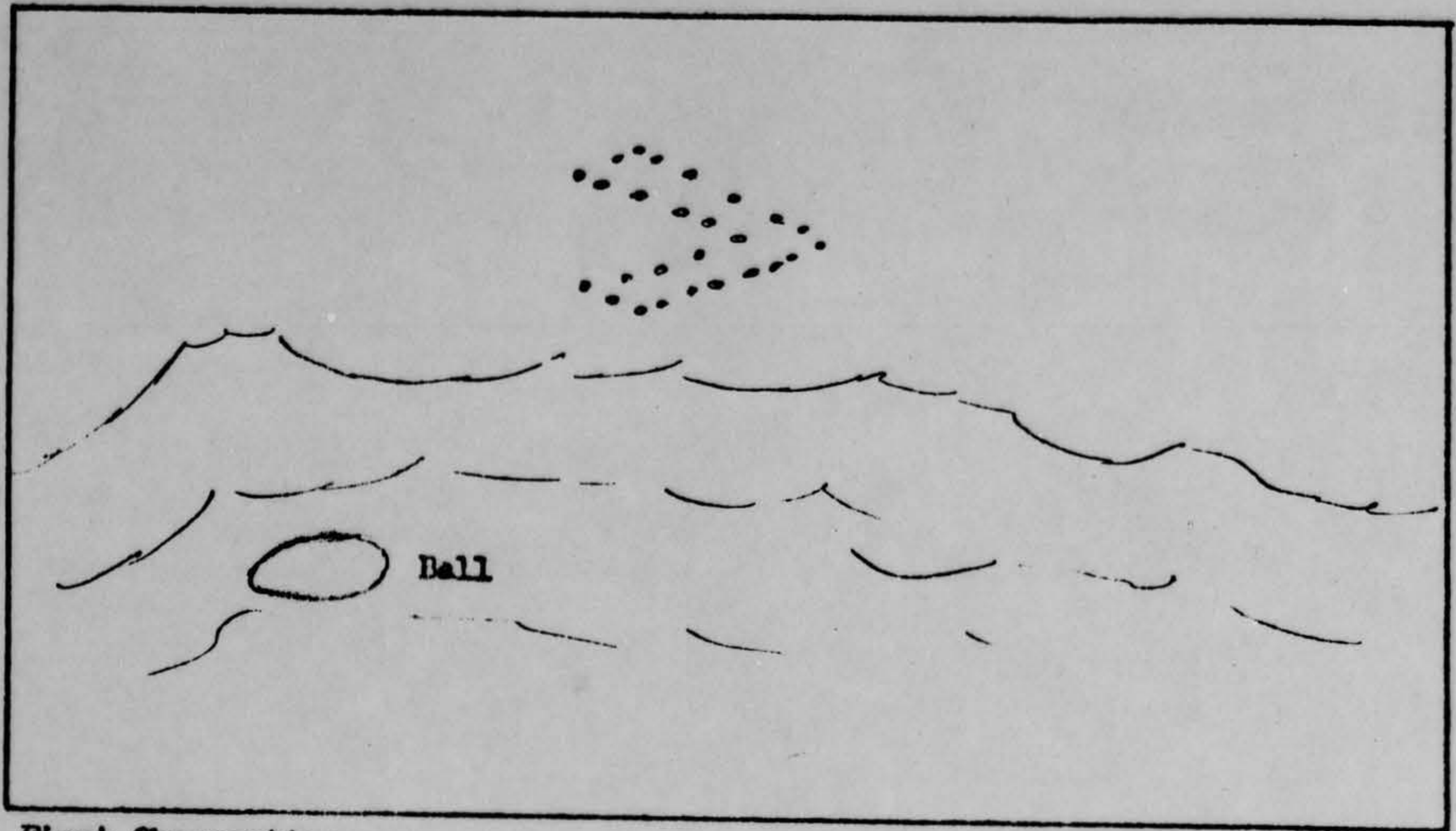
