Ref query to ATIC re blue-green globular object reported by many over Cleveland, Ohio on night of Nov., and press inquiries to your office.

Flt vectored over Cleveland to check. No obj in air. However, scattered clouds and contrails, with searchlights up from Cleveland found. Pressed repeatedly that blue or greenish-white beams often will blend with low ground, and only circular or elliptical reflection of searchlights underneath scattered clouds visible. This gives illusion of solid object moving rapidly in sky.

Report states movement counter-clockwise in circle. This typical of searchlights. Reporting observers cannot be considered very reliable as to est size: basketball size at max length would make object almost 3 miles in diameter at given altitude.
