JFOB REPORT # 18

DATE OF INCIDENT: 9 NOVEMBER 1957

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: VIC. AFTON, OKLAHOMA TIME: 0210 - 0300 hr (Z)  
(8:10 to 9:00 PM)

SUMMARY OF INCIDENT:

Apparently a red, white and green FLASHING light was observed in the vicinity of SE of AFTON, Oklahoma. Observer could not give shape only that it was flashing - and was still in the same position when he reported it.

Note: The flashing light must have been at some distance to the SE - as he required binoculars to see it.

INVESTIGATIVE EFFORTS:

- ① Complete check made of U.S. CG Aeronautical Charts No 359 + 360. Results: See Final Evaluation: below.
- ② Check of any <sup>other</sup> UFOs from Radar, GOC, air flight operations (mil. + civil), others from that area and general area. Results: Negative!

PHYSICAL EVIDENCE:

None.

FINAL ATIC EVALUATION:

Careful plot and check of facilities in the area of alleged sighting disclosed the following:

- a. A flashing beacon ESE of Afton - approx. 11 miles away
- b. A rotating flashing beacon, approx. 35 miles away - at Bentonville, Ark. SSE
- c. A rotating light - with code lights - also SE by 5 of near Taylorville, Ark.
