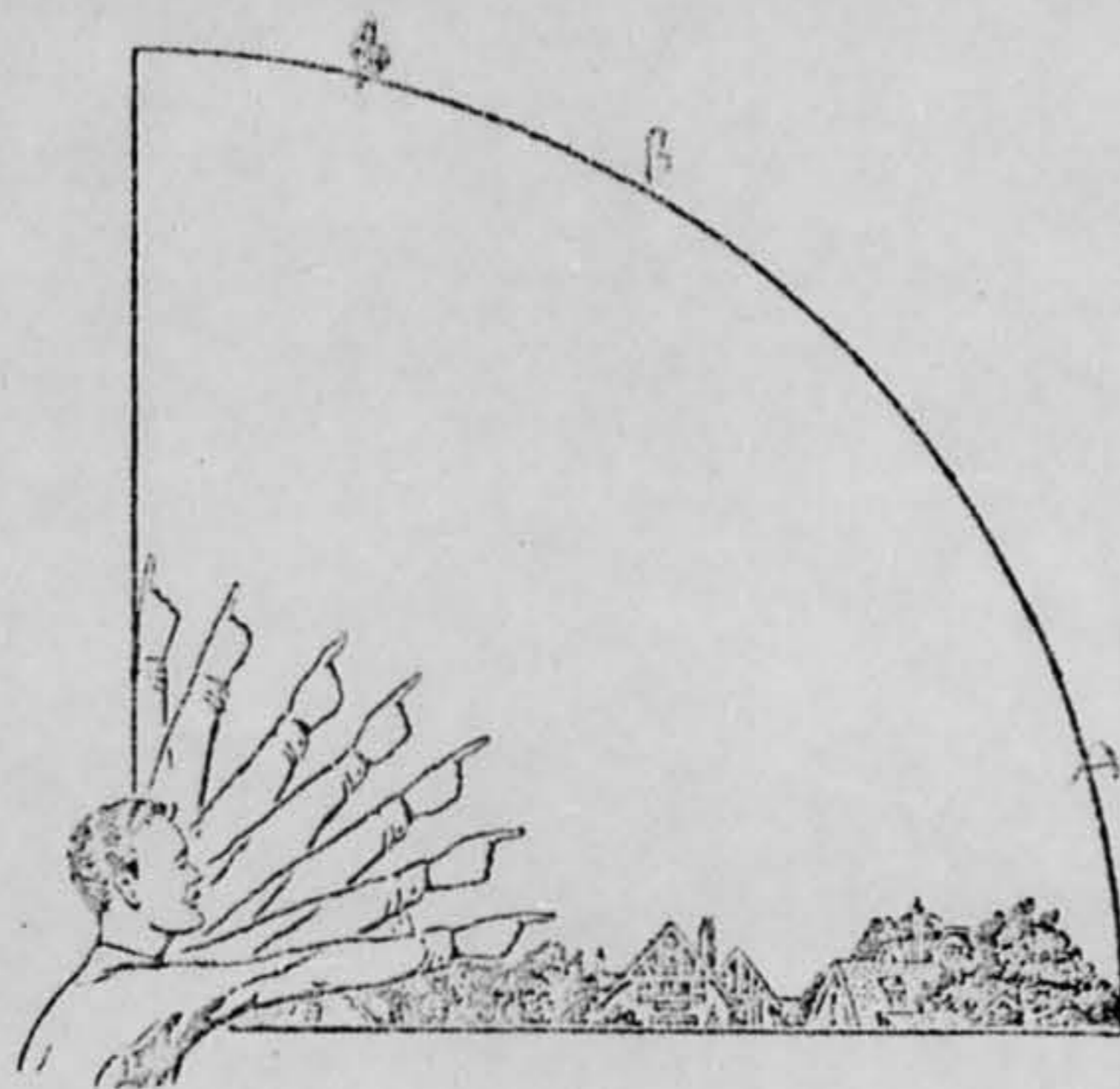

Dear Sirs,

To whom it may concern, if it better concern somebody, if it don't already in secret.

I am a recent resident of Fla., having been here only since 2 wks. I was privileged to witness something that a few other people must have seen before and in which I neither believed nor disbelieved until Wed evening Feb 10 at approx 7 PM. I suppose by now you know what is coming even before I tell you, but here it is for what you may care to do with the information. I mentioned it to only one person and that was a woman who owns a news stand, the following morning at which time I went to buy a paper expecting to find it all over the front page, but of which I found no mention whatever.

I was sitting in a drive in movie with my wife & 3 children. we were there approx 15 min. when I happened to glance at the north east sky which is the oppost direction of the screen. Right off to the right of the screen I saw a bright star I thought

only it moved (I had thought it was an airplane with its landing lights on, but there was only one big light). I thought it may be too far away that's why it looked like one light, but it kept getting bigger & closer & still only one light. By this time it was so unusual that I watched it carefully and saw it was a big white glowing light not a ball but a round light ~~of~~ sort of flat on top & bottom. Now I didn't see any object, just the light, so I don't know whether it was a saucer, or cup, or flying pan, but that is not important. It was moving almost toward me, so I couldn't tell only by its increase in size how fast it was going, it was fast. While it was moving a significant thing happened, for an instant only a bright flash appeared in the middle of the big light and as it did so the big glow diminished to about half brilliance but the bright light went out & the other light resumed its original brilliance & it continued to come on. Now at this point (and I could kick myself for it) something happened on the movie screen & I glanced at it for possibly 15 sec. then I glanced back to the object but it was no longer coming toward me instead it was going up & eastward, the light was now orange or so it appeared. Within approx 15 sec. from that time it started up & I watched it get smaller & smaller until it faded into the stars & disappeared out of sight. It looked like a rocket going up. Now this whole business didn't take more than 2 minutes.

At first I thought it was a rocket from Cape Canaveral but after thinking about it a rocket wouldnt be in lateral flight coming inland & then go up. so, I recalled reading some of the Pilots reports of balls of light & it fitted their description, so I apparently saw the same thing. Now the night was as clear as a bell and anybody could have seen it, but it happened so fast anybody could have missed it even me if I hadnt been looking at the movie screen which was right in line with it.

Now I dont want to belong to any flying saucer fan club I dont even want it mentioned but I do suggest if watching stations were set up by some kind of photo & radar for tracking them that a lot of them might be seen, and also that while we are messing around with rockets, there is already a proven mode of propulsion which we know nothing about, and if somebody isnt trying to find out how light or what could produce light in the atmosphere could be used as a propellant they better soon. also I would say the object disappeared at the speed which we cannot attain. As far as I am concerned we either have people on other planets or somebody on this planet is far more advanced than we thing. I dont mean Russia because they would have benched us out long ago if they had such things. It is pretty inconceivable anybody else on this planet has them, so they must be from outer space.

It is not so amazing that I observed this object successfully because ever since the flying saucer stories started I have been looking for one. I always like looking at the stars at night so it would be unusual for me to be looking up there especially here in Florida where it is unusually clear and dark in my area. I could not believe that all these responsible people who saw these objects were wrong so I always looked at any object I saw to try to determine just what it was by in the first 5 or so seconds I have seen many objects that at first I didn't know what they were but after carefully watching & listening within 5 or more minutes they were always identifiable as something we already know. When this object was appearing it looked like a plane with its landing lights on far off in the distance, where the lights would blend into one. As I approached I waited for the lights to separate but they did not & I could see the object was closer than I thought. At the meantime with the drive in movie going on when some loud distraction would come from the speaker I would glance at the screen. One time as a busy movie I glanced right back at the object to try to make it out. It was getting closer now and still was not identifiable and as I was watching it move along from north to south almost towards me I could feel suddenly and all business was as the light had separated but there in the open middle this happened for an instant and immediately the lights returned to their normal state when in the horizon but position of would say I had a full moment approx. to observe it at that time and by reason of

inspector. I glanced at the screen again just a few seconds longer than before. When I looked back to the object which should still be in front of me it was gone. I quickly looked around forward to look up from the windshield but I still could see no bright light which could have suggested so fast at its rate of travel. What I did see was a series of orange streaks already pretty far out in the sky. Some not in the white glow preceding the streaks but they just kept appearing with a space in between until it disappeared in the stars. The orange streaks stayed there 3 or 4 for at a time with a space in between until it would see one then they disappeared. They were just <sup>like this</sup> lines of orange light with a space at short regular intervals.

At first it didn't dawn on me as being a UFO but as I sat there trying to figure it out maybe it was a rocket from Cape Canaveral but that would not fly horizontal then vertical, especially vertical from my angle. I couldn't find the white light anywhere so I came to the same conclusion. I must have been a UFO. Incidentally the upward travel was at an amazing speed I would not care to estimate. I was thinking a jet may catch some of the exhaust trail but I don't know whether they could be fast enough. They would be if not in the air at the time. The next day I went for a paper in Sebring to read about it but there was nothing in the paper so I asked the woman at the news counter if anybody had seen any flying saucers last night and she could not say anything to her about it, so that is all I said. You it occurred to me that for many people to see an object for approx a min or more overhead was asking to much especially when I only saw it by accident, happening to be looking in the right place at the right time. I think it became so interesting enough to observe it. I wouldn't be surprised if more people saw it at the clinic or but just never followed it or saw it a second thought. It also occurred to me that there might be a lot of those of somebody would be just looking for them. I think there would be observation stations with radar just to see if there are. I incidentally of our radar didn't track them, you might as well throw it in the water as far as a defence against missiles are concerned. If there was a

nothing would like to know for my own satisfaction if there are at all possible and suit against regulation.

It has made me wonder why these things come by why don't they identify themselves by landing. There have been some landings which you may be sure of, but I don't know so I will have to suppose they have at times and not been observed. On the other hand of these people are oxygen breathing people it would not be impossible for them to just drop in for some fresh oxygen before going on for a million more miles wherever they may be going. It is also possible that if Russia can send a rocket around the moon and photograph it that the people who are far more advanced could send small automatic machines as this one with no one on them, all around the universe to observe all the planets.

It's quite possible that in the past they have had and experience with helping people from the planets to modernize. They may know other planets just to find out how far advanced they are and if not so far they just ignore them but if they become as we are beginning to be, in the space age they may observe us carefully to see whether we would be friendly or an enemy. Having the last observation I would definitely set up observation stations and not try to capture one but try to attract one, because a hostile one may come there to just atomize this world, which for them may be possible. We may not know it but there may be all kinds of interplanetary travel outside of our immediate sphere of living. You can only possibly think of all these things if you have the privileged to see one of these, and no matter what anybody tells you, you don't doubt your observation.

Following this line of reasoning there is a very important and possibly never thought of field of thought, and that is religion.

Being a Christian and a believer in the formation of our world by God, the birth of Christ, of all the ~~the~~ other aspects of Christian belief such as why we are created, what happens when we die, <sup>and</sup> believing we are the only ones in the universe. It is kind of disturbing to all of a sudden realize that possibly all of our observations are in fact

one, saying: "Nobody ever said there was not more people in the universe."  
If it is reasonable to assume that there are other planets with moons  
& suns like ours after all what is the purpose of all the  
millions of stars and planets, nobody has yet found out. I think  
many intelligent and serious-minded people such as scientists, clergy  
& defence personnel should examine the facts and seriously consider  
all the possibilities as regards these things. They also try to see one for  
themselves because only then can you realize the exact possibilities.

-I could not have written a letter ~~such~~ such as this before I  
saw this thing, even though I was of the opinion that a lot of these  
people did see something. If the mere fact that I was looking for  
one and finally saw one means that they are here and ready to  
be observed, let me remember you may only have one minute for your  
observation. Since this happened - I examine the sky every night for about  
15 min. I have seen only 3 shooting stars or so we believe. Could it not be  
that they were these things passing through our upper atmosphere who know?  
just a thought, but I will accept our present belief as to shooting stars.

But nobody can tell me what I saw that night was not a U.F.O.

To give you accurate information I bought a compass & went  
back to the movie, parked the car in the same place & observed  
everything as carefully as I could. I thought maybe it would be  
very important to know where it disappeared because it went like  
a rocket in that direction. I am sure that if its destination was west  
it would have gone west. Possibly knowing what is in space in  
that direction may be a clue. It could have been a space ship in  
the stratosphere and this was a little pilot ship.

I would like to discuss this with anybody interested  
in the perceptive views, but am not interested in the negative as  
we have seen one. I think now people should observe the sky at night  
all night never leaving it for a minute because you only have one minute  
as I said before.




I sincerely hope that anything and everything I have told you will be of some help <sup>and</sup> if there is any further help I can give I will be glad to.

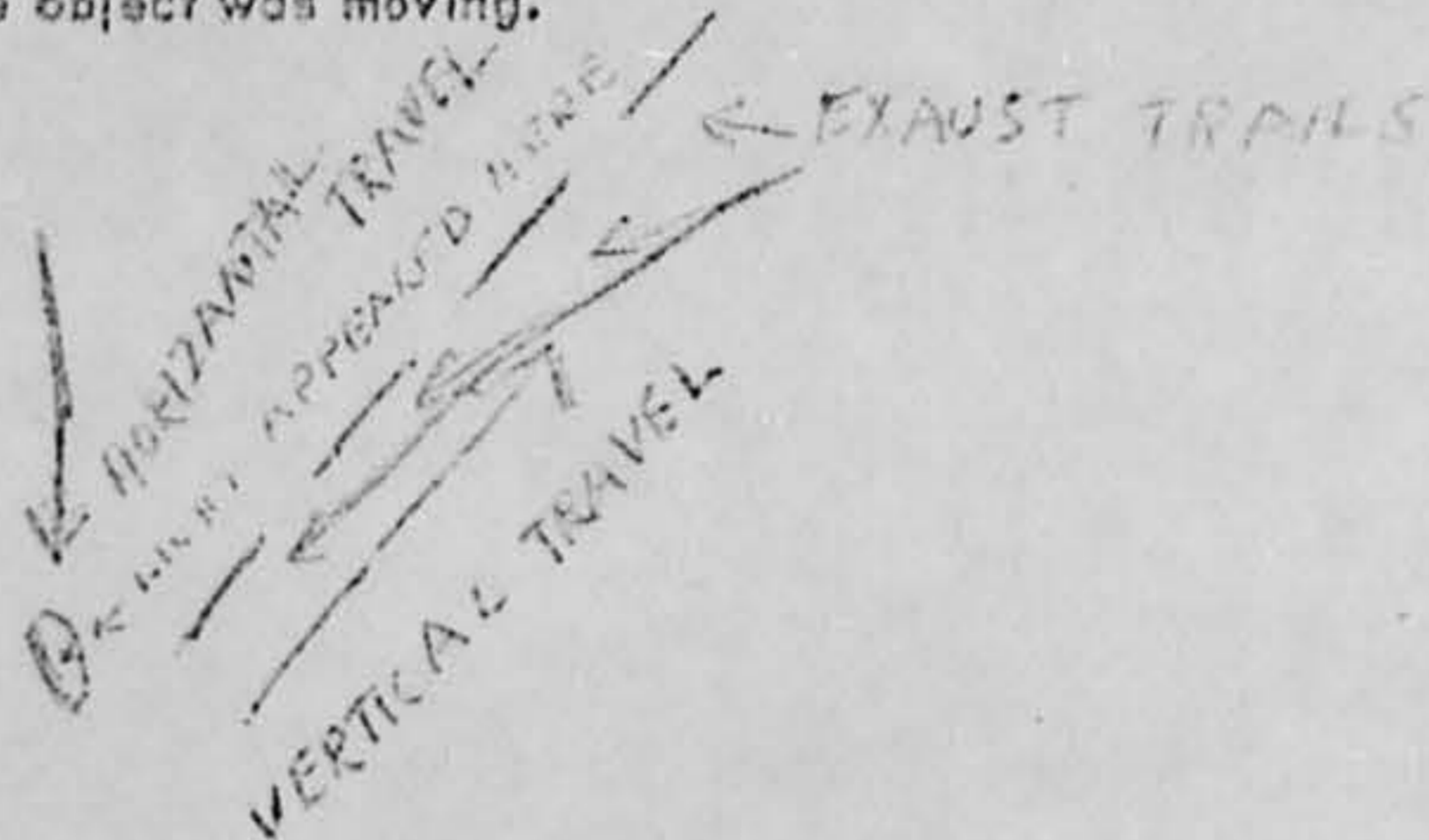
