- 1. Analysis of the movie film reveals nothing of an unusual nature. The film was poorly exposed and the panning was such that it is plausable to assume that a child was taking the pictures. There was also an indication of a light leak on certain portions of the film. The Air Intelligence Information Report was of no value as there was nothing in the film which even remotely resembled the objects mentioned in the report.
