(b) Grapefruit, held at arms length. Appeared to be approximately 10 feet in diameter.

(c) Negative

(d) Total of five sightings, three in the first sighting, and five in each of the four other sightings.

(e) Always perfect trail formation

(f) Strong white light shining downward with red glow, apparently from within objects.

(g) N/A

(h) Negative, even though witness states objects appeared to be only fifty to one hundred ft. high.

(i) Objects would stand perfectly still for periods of several minutes then move off at a very slow pace (about the speed of a person walking) and then after several min, move out of sight at very high speeds.

(2)(a) Lights

(b) First sighting - ten degrees above horizon, south east of house. Other sightings always low on horizon but from varying directions.

(c) Twenty to thirty degrees, varying azimuth.

(d) Objects always moved in definite, straight line, made sharp, in trail turns and varied speed from walking speed to very fast.

(e) Gradually got dimmer as distance increased. On one occasion, they disappeared into clouds.

(f) From twenty to thirty minutes each time.
