2. This information came from the British West Indies Airlines through NORAD, then through the AF Command Post (WPAFB, Maj Nebbal). At 26/0207Z a British Viscount Airlines enroute from San Jan Puerto Rico to Barbadas spotted a bright white object with a green center which disintegrated into a green colored object.
