1. Attached hereto is photographic evidence to accompany DAOIO message 2343, this headquarters dated 18 July 1960 concerning Unidentified Flying Object Report of observers [redacted]

2. Photographic aid used by observer was an 8mm Revere eyematic movie camera with 32.5mm, F1.8 telescopic lens of Wollensak manufacture. There were no filters or tripods in use. Type of film was Kodakchrome Type A daylight film. Panning was employed and camera was pointed easterly at approximately 50 degrees elevation from the earth.

Description Box shaped, size of pencil erasure, silvery-reflected sunlight, three objects in line formation approx 2 miles apart, first seen 50 deg elev, last seen 30 to 35 deg elev, moved at very slow rate of speed in a straight and level path, seen for about 5 minutes


Evaluation of Source Reliability UNKNOWN

Analysis and Conclusions: ONE WITNESS IDENTIFIED THE OBJECTS AS PROBABLY HELICOPTERS. THE OBJECTS WERE IN SIGHT APPROXIMATELY FIVE MINUTES AND DURING THIS PERIOD MOVED OVER CONSIDERABLE ANGULAR DISTANCE. THE ABSENCE OF SOUND IS DUE TO DISTANCE AND WIND DIRECTION, WHICH WAS GENERALLY FROM THE WITNESSES AND TOWARD THE OBJECT. THE IMAGES ON THE 8MM FILM COULD NOT BE IDENTIFIED AND EFFORTS TO DETERMINE IF HELICOPTERS WERE IN THE AREA (over)

met with failure. The covers, based on the information provided by the workers, could possibly be heliocopters.


It is concluded that the objects of this sighting were probably heliicopters.







