Analysis and Conclusions: THE OBJECT FOR THIS SIGHTING IS PROBABLY A MISSILE FIRED FROM CAPE CANAVERAL. THE OBJECT WAS SEEN OVER THE CANAVERAL RANGE AREA AND TRAVELING PARALLEL TO THE RANGE COURSE. IT COINCIDES WITH A FIRING SCHEDULED FOR THE 27th AND THE DESCRIPTION FITS THAT OF MISSILES PREVIOUSLY REPORTED. THIS REPORT CONTAINED VERY LITTLE INFORMATION — Friend
